





The Quel'dorei faced exile, and later came to face the Amani trolls without the assembled might of the Kaldorei empire behind them. The Shal'dorei, too, faced the prospect of an eternity believing themselves to be the last living beings in the world, and struggled to reform their civilization and survive into the unknown future.

The struggles faced by these ancient elven people marked a new age, one in which, through adversity, all of elven kind would later thrive, despite all the odds. The Kaldorei would forge a thriving, albeit reclusive civilization amongst the ruins of Kalimdor; the Quel'dorei would build a prosperous empire in a new land, and create the Sunwell to sustain themselves after their severance from the Well of Eternity; the Shal'dorei, too, would address their severance from the Well of Eternity by creating the Nightwell to sustain themselves, and later forge a kingdom of both elegance and sophistication.

Each in their own way, the descendents of the ancient Kaldorei made their mark anew on the world.

And yet each would come to face the threat of annihilation once again, this time in the Great Wars, and those which came after.

The ambitions and determination of Illidan Stormrage which both further courted the influence and meddling of the Legion, and brought about its ultimate demise.




Start of the Great Wars

- The Dark Portal Opens


- The Dark Portal is opened and the Orcish Horde charges into Azeroth first targeting the Kingdom of Stormwind.
- The Horde takes time to establish war camps and builds up an arsenal of siege weapons, along with supplies to fund their genocidal campaign.
 - The Horde rampages across the Black Morass, a swamp to the east of the Kingdom of Stormwind, and begins attacking human settlements on the far edges of the kingdom.
- Tyrannea Lightharte is born outside Silvermoon City in Quel'Thalas.
 - The daughter of farmers Illiana and Tekeny Lightharte, she is raised in the outdoors and is reluctant to study, something her parents forced to compel upon her.
- Discovering the dark magics at work in the south, Aegwynn discovers her son to be behind the Horde's invasion, and resolves to stop him.





- Heart Fever -

- Mutations of diseases from Draenor spread to the human population on Azeroth in the Kingdom of Stormwind, developing into Heart Fever, a vicious sickness that poisons the blood, and causes the heart to become swollen, and then burst.
 - Nori'del Virtris arrives in the Kingdom of Stormwind while still journeying amongst the human and dwarven kingdoms.
 - As the Heart Fever spreads throughout the human settlements in Stormwind, Noridel Virtris works to heal and bless the sick, drawing on his knowledge of human faith gained during his travels. Despite saving lives where he journeyed, the sheer number of fatalities as a result of the sickness is staggering.
- Dorian Fallowmarsh is born in Silvermoon City.
 - The son of **Ilsia** and **Ban'oriel Fallowmarsh**, renowned explorers, he is their first child and is invested in his family's adventuring business at a young age.
- Emilia Raldari escapes from her captivity after the slavers' camp is raided. She flees and manages to evade any pursuit.
 - She is eventually discovered by a band of traveling monks who provide her shelter, and give her sanctuary amongst their troope.
- King Llane Wrynn sends word to the northern kingdoms, but is openly mocked, and Stormwind is left to fight the Horde on its own with few believing the stories coming from the southern kingdom.
 - O Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough is among a number of individuals in Quel'Thalas who advocate for the Thalassian military to venture forth and investigate the rumors of foreign invaders. He is forbidden from doing so, and instead begins to


amongst the other magisters.

- Anduin Lothar is appointed the "King's Champion", and tasked with leading Stormwind's military against the Horde.
- Ranger-Corporal Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker is deployed south to the Farstrider Lodge in eastern Khaz Modan, along the mountains dividing Loch Modan from the Wildhammer Highlands.

Year 3

The First War Begins –

- Captain Caspen'alar Starbreeze and his son, Venthar Starbreeze—now a seasoned sailor in his own right and an officer aboard *Silverspell*—answer the call of Stormwind and sail south aboard *Silverspell* to aid the humans.
 - Though having traveled without permission, both father and son offer their services in ferrying human soldiers along the coasts to help them more efficiently counter the Horde, acting out of a sense of obligation for good friendships started ages prior.
- Lakeshire is attacked and destroyed by the Horde, marking the first major battle and loss of the war.
 - Westfall and Brightwood also suffer attacks by the Horde, and quickly fall before the onslaught.
 - O Norr'del Virtris remains in Stormwind, aiding the humans in their struggle against the Horde, and formally joins into the human's Church of the Holy Light.
- At the age of twenty four, the young sorcerer Cael'braen Sunbreeze is drawn into the confidence of a Silvermoon magister who introduces him to darker magics.




- The Horde occupies part of Blackrock Mountain.
- The dwarves of Khaz Modan, with the aid of the Quel'dorei Farstriders operating out of lodges based in the region, harass and harry the Horde's forces when the orcs venture too far to the north.
 - Ranger-Corporal Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker is among the Farstriders who fight to keep the Horde at bay.


Hespir Everwyern is born in Quel'Thalas.

- He is the younger brother of Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern.
- Elwynn Forest is invaded by the Horde.
 - Northshire Valley falls to the Horde.
 - Survivors and refugees escape to Stormwind City through underground tunnels.
- Commander Zandayn Starbreeze sails south aboard her ship, Dawning Sword, to aid the kingdom of Stormwind and her father and brother, Captain Caspen'alar and Venthar Starbreeze.
- The Horde lays siege to Stormwind City for the first time, but are taken by surprise when Anduin Lothar leads Stormwind's armies around to attack their flanks during the siege.
 - Striking at the Horde's armies from both the front and the rear, the siege is broken, and the Horde suffers the greatest defeat in its entire history.
 - Anduin Lothar earns his reputation as one of the greatest commanders in human history.
- Medivh, the Guardian of Azeroth, is found to have betrayed humanity and being the one responsible for summoning the Horde into Azeroth.
 - Anduin Lothar, Khadgar Medivh's apprentice, and Garona Halforcen lead a strike into Karazhan and battle the Guardian. Khadgar is severely wounded in the battle, Garona flees, but ultimately Medivh, the Last Guardian of Azeroth, is slain.





- Battling through the wildlands of Kalimdor, the company is confronted by Kaldorei sentinels and a bloody skirmish erupts. The Quel'dorei plunge deeper in the wilderness, hunted constantly by the Kaldorei sentinels.
- Upon arriving at the ruins of Eldre'thalas, the company finds themself unable to venture too deep into the ruins given the state of the city, and are able to extract only limited information.
- They discover the ghosts of the Shen'dralar, but are driven out by the hostile spirits.
 Empty handed, the sorcerers return to Quel'Thalas and seek alternative methods of preparation.
- **Orgrim Doomhammer**, a chief lieutenant of the Horde, challenges **Warchief Blackhand** for leadership of the Horde believing him too weak to carve out a victory.
 - **Orgrim** kills **Blackhand** with his family's weapon, the Doomhammer, and claims the mantle of Warchief for himself.
 - With the Shadow Council disabled following the sudden incapacity of **Gul'dan**, **Orgrim Doomhammer** banishes Fel magic within the Horde, believing it to have driven the orcish people from their culture and tradition.
- Nori'del Virtris boards a ship and sails north to Lordaeron, escaping the Kingdom of Stormwind and the reach of the Horde during the First War.
- In Quel'Thalas, Tirian Felo'dorah and other knights of the Blue Lance are dispatched to guard the southern borders of the Kingdom.
- Orgrim Doomhammer turns his focus towards Stormwind and leads an all out siege.
 - Ouring the siege, **Garona** returns to Stormwind and assassinates **King Llane**, leading to a breakdown of morale and resolve within the ranks of the human defenders.



- The capital city, Stormwind, is razed by the Orcish Horde, and the kingdom falls.
- Emilia Raldari, now freed from captivity, but still critically unwell and in the process of long recovery while in the company of a band of traveling monks, is taken to the Temple of Serenity in Pandaria as the monks return home.
 - Given the often elusive nature of the Pandaren, especially in the years before the mists parted, the specifics of how this travel was effected is unclear.
 - For many years after she trains amongst the monks and is given refuge there within the temple.

– The Second War Begins –


- Refugees from Stormwind are taken in by the Kingdom of Lordaeron, and a council is convened to rally support to fight against the Horde.
 - The Alliance of Lordaeron is forged, consisting of the Kingdoms of Stormwind, Lordaeron, Stromgarde, Gilneas, Alterac, the island nation of Kul Tiras, and the Magocracy of Dalaran.
 - Representatives of Quel'Thalas, the Wildhammer and Bronzebeard clans of dwarves, and the gnomes of Gnomeregan are also contacted, but are unable or unwilling to initially deploy troops.
 - Captain Caspen'alar Starbreeze, his son Venthar Starbreeze, and his adopted daughter Commander Zandayn Starbreeze all remain in Lordaeron after the fall of Stormwind, and officially commit themselves, their crews, and their ships to the Alliance despite not having permission from Quel'Thalas.





 - The Dwarves offer stiff resistance to the Horde's advances.
- Ironforge and Blackrock Mountain are besieged by the Horde.


- The upper half of Blackrock Mountain remains locked down, having been taken over by the Horde, and the Dark Iron Dwarves secluded deep within the mountain are deterred from aggressing against the Horde's forces.
- Ironforge endures a siege that lasts for years.
- The Horde continues its brutal conquest on the warpath north, conquering Khaz Modan and inching towards the Arathi Highlands.
 - The Alliance forces prepare to fight back against the Horde.
 - Ranger-Corporal Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker is among the elven Farstriders based in the Khaz Modan region who are withdrawn further north, and settle in at the Quel'Danil Lodge in the Hinterlands in anticipation of the Horde's further advances.
 - Quin'd David Dav
 - Agents of the Horde seek out the Amani trolls of Zul'Aman and attempt to strike a pact with the Amani leader, **Zul'jin**. Believing the Amani would succeed without the aid of the Horde, **Zul'jin** refuses, only to be later captured by the humans and imprisoned within Durnholde Keep in the Foothills of southern Lordaeron.
 - The forest trolls begin to strike at the Quel'dorei throughout the woods of southern Quel'Thalas.



- First Lieutenant Ranger Ker'tina Silverflight and her brother, **Lyrindel Silverflight** are present as part of **Lireesa's** company, and narrowly survive the Amani ambush.
- Ranger General Lireesa Windrunner is slain by the Amani trolls.
- She is succeeded by **Sylvanas Windrunner**, her daughter, as Ranger General of Quel'Thalas after her eldest daughter, **Alleria Windrunner**, refuses the mantle.
- Alleria Windrunner disobeys King Anasterian's orders and leads an additional contingent of elven forces to join with the Alliance armies.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern, Erilihn Autumnsong, Kandravia Boltseeker, Magister Feanor Quel'dorah, Iradri Ashwalker, and Adela Duskrider travel south with the Quel'dorei, against orders.
 - While in Lordaeron, Kandravia Boltseeker works to train human archers and other ranged support units, and is later assigned to defend Durnholde Keep.
- Akirle Starsong is among the many Kirin Tor magi who begin to study the dark magics being utilized by the Horde.
- Anticipating stiff resistance at the Thandol Span, a narrow crossing between Khaz Modan and the northern human nations, **Warchief Orgrim Doomhammer** orders the Horde to construct a fleet of warships to make the cross by sea.
 - This unanticipated move strikes the Alliance by surprise.
 - While in the region, the Horde enslaves the Red Dragonflight, with assistance from the Black Dragonflight, by capturing the Red Dragonflight Aspect **Alexstrasza the Life-Binder** and compelling her submission with the use of the <u>Demon Soul</u>.
- The Horde fleet sails for Lordaeron, but is intercepted by the Kul Tiran war fleet, under the command of **Grand Admiral Daelin Proudmoore**.
 - Elven destroyers Silverspell and Dawning Sword, under the command of Captain
 Caspen'alar Starbreeze and Commander Zandayn Starbreeze, respectively, join with the



- Ashwalker, Adela Duskrider, and Kirin Tor Archmage Voratthel Skyshroud take part in the Battle of Hillsbrad alongside the elven and human forces.
 The Horde's advance is slowed in Hillsbrad by fierce fighting, and with both the path
- through Alterac and Silverpine blocked.
- The Horde unleashes the first Death Knights against the Alliance, and also deploys necromancers to reanimate the dead.
- The experience of seeing the dead raised into undeath strikes an unforgettable feeling of failure and sickness in Iradri Ashwalker, viewing each of the slain as a failure of her own.
- Magus Rastanil Goldthorn is deployed in the battles as a reserve guard attached with the elven rangers, using his skills as a spellblade to guard them from opportunist attacks by the Horde's soldiers.
- Warchief Orgrim Doomhammer leads the Horde in an assault against Durnholde Keep, where the Amani chieftain Zul'jin is held in captivity. Kandravia Boltseeker is among those defending Durnholde Keep at the time of Warchief Doomhammer's assault.
- Warchief Doomhammer frees Zul'jin, and secures the strength of the Amani within the ranks of the Horde.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker leads a company of Farstriders in a prolonged guerilla campaign against the Horde, striking them in the dead of night to keep on edge and agitated.
- Seeking an alternative route north, the Horde seals a pact with the Amani trolls and pushes east, into the Hinterlands.



- The Horde divides its forces and outmaneuvers the Alliance, striking north towards
 Quel'Thalas along the eastern mountains, bound by oath to destroy the elven kingdom
 in return for the support of the Amani trolls.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker continues to lead Farstrider rangers against the Horde, striking at them all across the Hinterlands, and along the eastern mountains of Lordaeron.
- Anduin Lothar, Turalyon, and Alleria Windrunner lead a force in pursuit of the Horde through the Hinterlands, and north towards Quel'Thalas.
 - Present amongst their forces are Maginer Feanor Quel'dorah, Kandravia Boltseeker,
 Magus Rastanil Goldthorn, Iradri Ashwalker, and Archmage Voratthel Skyshroud.
 - Iradri Ashwalker and a division of soldiers rush to bypass the Horde and return hastily to Quel'Thalas to warn and prepare the kingdom's defenses.


- The Alliance of Lordaeron Fights Back -

- Anduin Lothar leads the forces of the Alliance of Lordaeron in battling the Horde in Hillsbrad, the Hinterlands, and upon the high seas with the support of other heroes of the Alliance such as Grand Admiral Daelin Proudmoore, Gilnean King Genn Greymane, Danath Trollbane of Stromgarde, Ranger-Captain Alleria Windrunner, Khadgar, and the paladins Uther the Lightbringer, Turalyon, Saidan Dathrohan, Tirion Fordring, and Gavinrad.
 - The Alliance is pushed back by the Horde inch by inch.
 - O Syori Dawnflame remains attached with Alliance forces in Hillsbrad, and continues to hold the line against the Horde's advances.
- Akirie Starsong aids other Kirin Tor sorcerers in tutoring and training new students to aid the Alliance war effort.



- The Burning of Quei Thatas -

- The forest trolls emerge en masse from the forests of Zul'Aman and assault the kingdom of Quel'Thalas alongside the Horde, cementing the Quel'dorei's full throated support for the Alliance of Lordaeron.
- Anduin Lothar's forces in the east are able to aid the Wildhammer Dwarves and lift the siege of the Aerie Peak, earning the support of the dwarves and their thane, Kurdran Wildhammer.
 - Their gryphon riders join into the Alliance army and prove effective at countering the dragon mounted riders of the Horde.
 - Magus Rastanil Goldthorn is introduced to a Wildhammer dwarf by the name of Roac; the two develop a friendship that would last well into the future.
- Many Quel'dorei join in the defense of Quel'Thalas against the Horde.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough's fears of an inevitable conflict with the Horde are realized, and he leads his apprentices, and many other magi, in an aggressive campaign against the Horde to defend Quel'Thalas.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker reunites with the larger Farstrider host in Quel'Thalas and continues to aid their efforts in waging a brutal guerilla campaign against the Horde. She and her forces harry the orcs and trolls along the southern and eastern flanks.
 - Lord Mordinathin Skyshrond leads the Skyshroud family in battle against the Horde.
 He is joined by his daughter, Magistrix Taileth, his sister, Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud, and his nephew and niece, Magister Daine and Magistrix Sorenadal Skyshroud.
 - Thorruless Ralomyar and Iradri Ashwalker are deployed to the southern borders of Quel'Thalas alongside the Farstriders and soldiers of the army. There, they face the Orcish Horde and the Amani trolls in close-quarters fighting.



- Vynlorin Shandaumath's aunt and uncle, both magisters, join the Quel'dorei forces in battling the Horde. Vynlorin continues his training in Quel'Thalas, however, and does not engage in the war.
- O Narsyssa Blackwood joins the Quel'dorei in battling the Horde within Quel'Thalas. During the conflict she loses both her parents, and her extended family. She and her sister are the last two Blackwoods surviving.
- Ara'dana Dawnfire and Cael'braen Sunbreeze join other elven spellcasters in battling
 the Horde, and witnesses first hand the power of the Horde's dark magic, including
 necromancy.
- Vangellis Falwellow journeys to the front lines to serve as a smith in the war campaigns
 as the Quel'dorei hold back the Horde, but does not engage in the fighting.
- O Haeldron Dawnbrook, Zariasona Emberspirit and her family, Llyreth Starseeker, Tirian Felo'dorah and the Knights of the Blue Lance, and Ethrian Duskrider also join the Quel'dorei in battling the Horde within Quel'Thalas, with the latter taking many mounted rangers and harassing the Horde army where possible to slow their advance. The mounted spellbows grapple with the enslaved ruby dragons, but are able to evade heavy losses due to the advantage of high mobility.
- The Sunfeather family estate in southeastern Quel'Thalas is burned by the Horde, and the noble family takes shelter in Silvermoon City. Sae'themar Sunfeather himself does



 - O Syori Dawnflame's brother, Vyndan, is slain by the Horde.


- Elb'athalan, the Skyshroud family estate and academy for magical studies is attacked and destroyed by the Amani, with the aid of the Dragonmaw ruby dragon riders. The Skyshroud family withdraws to Silvermoon.
- Iradri Ashwalker and the forces she is attached to are driven back towards the capital city bit by bit as the invasion continues.
- Cael'braen Sumbreeze and a company of Farstriders manage to wound an enslaved ruby dragon, downing it and killing its rider. Cael'braen battles against the wounded drake, unleashing shadow magic upon it.
 - The overwhelming use of shadow magic corrupts the dragon and, though intentional, empowers it with new, dangerous abilities.



- Iradri Ashwalker, Tirian Felo'dorah and the Knights of the Blue Lance withdraw to Silvermoon City and hold the line against the Horde.
- Ellahora Emberlight and her family endure the Siege of Silvermoon within the walls.
- Ethrian Duskrider, Thorruless Ralomyar, First Lieutenant Ranger Ker'tina Silverflight, and her brother, Lyrindel Silverflight, are some of those trapped outside the walls of Silvermoon City during the siege; they wage a guerilla campaign against the Horde with the support of other forces stranded in the woodlands.


- They suffer many losses, which deeply affect the rangers in particular and fuel a tremendous resentment and animosity towards the Horde races.
- Ivanna Quel'dorah, mother to Magister-Féanor Chel'dorah, is slain in the family's home when the Horde's orcish forces arrive.
 - With Magister France's father and brother, Elros and Vardamir Quel'dorah, both having been called up for service, Ivanna is alone when she is killed.
- Within the besieged Silvermoon City, Cael'braen Sunbreeze is confronted by the city's high ranking magisters regarding his use of darker magics.
 - Given a choice between forsaking those powers, or being exiled, Cael braen Sunbreeze chooses to submit to the magistry and swear off the use of darker magics. Though he intends to abide by his word, he harbors resentment towards those forcing the choice upon him.
 - Cael'braen Sunbreeze is confronted by his parents, who chide the young sorcerer for his failures and inability to rise to more than just a disgraced magus.





- Ranger General Sylvanas Windrunner is reunited with her sister, Ranger-Captain Alleria Windrunner. Ranger General Sylvanas presents Alleria with their mother's bow, <u>Thas'dorah</u>, and bids her to take vengeance upon the trolls with it.
- Magister Feanor Quel'dorah returns to his family's home along the shores of Lake Elrendar to find his mother, **Ivanna Quel'dorah**, dead.
- Caspen'alar Starbreeze, captain of the elven destroyer *Silverspell*, is slain aboard his ship during an attack by one of the enslaved ruby dragons, and his son, Venthar Starbreeze, assumes command after his passing.
- Ara'dana Dawnfire leads a small party of magi and rangers, including Cael'braen Sunbreeze, beyond the city walls in pursuit of several orcish warlocks, and manages to take one as a prisoner.
 - Ara'dana Dawnfire and Cael'braen Sunbreeze take part in the interrogation of the orcish warlock and learn much of the Horde's darker magics, and their origins. It is through this that Ara'dana becomes more intimately aware of necromancy, shadow magic, and fel magic. For Cael'braen, it is an affirmation of the potential power at his fingertips if he only committed himself fully.
 - Magus Braelyn Firehand is, at some point during this time, contacted by Gul'dan's
 Shadow Council and drawn into the fold of those supporting the Burning Legion in
 secret. She maintains her secrecy throughout the years to follow.



- Syori Dawnflame and other Alliance forces in Hillsbrad are redeployed to the capital of Lordaeron to prepare for the inevitability of a siege.
 - It is during this time that she learns of the death of her brother, who had been killed defending Quel'Thalas from the Horde.
- With the Amani left alone to continue the siege, the Quel'dorei and Alliance forces break out of Silvermoon and drive back the trolls.
 - Tirian Felo'dorah and the Knights of the Blue Lance wage a brutal campaign against the Amani as the elven counteroffensive begins.
 - Within the Blue Lance, resentments towards the Alliance festers, born out of a sense of betrayal and abandonment by the southern nations during the early days of the brutal orcish campaign in Quel'Thalas.
 - The Skyshroud family breaks out into Eversong Forest after the lifting of the siege and aid in the pursuit of the Amani and Horde forces. They recapture Elb'athalan, their family estate, and then work to secure the borders of the kingdom.
 - O Magus Rastanil Goldthorn, Kandravia Boltseeker, Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker, and Ranger-Captain Alleria Windrunner are among the many Farstriders who scour the woodlands of remaining Amani trolls.
 - Siblings Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Commander Zandayn Starbreeze take their ships, *Silverspell* and *Dawning Sword*, and pursue the Horde south, aiding Alliance forces in tearing the orcish juggernauts apart.
- Cael'braen Sunbreeze ventures out into the southern woodlands of Quel'Thalas and once again delves into shadow magics, and also now fel magic.
 - The young sorcerer experiments with these new, darker powers, perfecting his craft upon the Amani trolls he hunts down in the woodlands.




Led by Warchief Orgrim Doomhammer, the Horde marches west towards the heart of the Kingdom of Lordaeron.

party ambushes Halduron Brightwing's forces and breaks Zul'jin free.

The Kingdom of Alterac betrays the Alliance and grants passage through their lands to **Orgrim Doomhammer's** armies-enabling their hasty advance towards Lordaeron's Capital City through the Alterac Mountains from the east and south.

The Alliance Counter Offensive –

- The Alliance forces in Quel'Thalas lead a lightning offensive to liberate the elven lands, decimating the ranks of the Amani and driving them to the brink of extinction.
 - Thorruless Ralomyar, Iradri Ashwalker, Skyshroud, and Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud journey with the Alliance forces in pushing the Horde south.
 - , Zalvie Flameblade, Kandravia Boltseeker, Llyreth Starseeker, and Ethrian Duskrider remain in Quel'Thalas with the elven forces to continue the pursuit and decimation of the Amani ranks.
 - Iradri Ashwalker and Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker are a part of the forces that breach the gates of Zul'Aman and lay waste to the Amani trolls within. turn south to pursue the Horde.





- Tyrannea Lightharte and her family return to their farmstead outside of Silvermoon City once the region is deemed secure.
 - Struck by fear of future invasions, Tyrannea Lightharte's father pushes her to embrace the path of a priestess, and to take her schooling more seriously.
 - She begins to study under Quel'dorei priests within the High Home.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough continues to serve with the Alliance throughout the
 war, acting as an advisor and expert in the darker magics used by the Horde which he had spent
 much of his earlier centuries studying and experimenting alongside his fellow sorcerers.
 - He catalogs and documents a great deal of information regarding the Horde's magic, including their use of the Fel and necromancy.
- Tirian Felo'dorah and the Knights of the Blue Lance continue their campaign against the Amani long after the Horde is driven out of Quel'Thalas, and even follow them into Lordaeron and Zul'Aman in an aggressive effort to exact vengeance for losses suffered during the Horde's invasion.
 - Tensions within the Blue Lance rise over whether to continue pursuing the Amani, or returning to the High Home. Tirian Felo dorah and his mentor, **Bull**, nearly come to blows over differing views on the matter.
 - After a long campaign, **Bull**, the senior surviving member of the Blue Lance, orders the company home. He chastises the knights for having lost their way in pursuit of vengeance, rather than honoring their duty to protect the High Home.
 - The Knights of the Blue Lance turn north, towards Quel'Thalas, and return home.
- The Horde lays siege to the Capital City of Lordaeron.
 - The Horde falters during the siege as Turalyon and Ranger-Captain Alleria
 Windrunner's forces assault the Horde from the east, having broken out of Quel'Thalas, and internal fighting weakens the Horde army.



- Knowing defeat is imminent with the massing Alliance reinforcements now bearing down upon him at Lordaeron, **Warchief Orgrim Doomhammer** orders the Horde to retreat, and the Alliance liberates the Capital City.
- Tirian Felo'dorah and the Knights of the Blue Lance, having returned to Quel'Thalas, begin to recruit and train new squires and knights, and also begin to recruit new pages.
 - The order's ranks swell with new recruits, elves from all across the kingdom who are eager to prevent another invasion, and to defend the High Home.
 - Tirian Felo'dorah is assigned a page of his own, **Yvresse Thas'ban**, nicknamed **Mother** given her sharing Tirian's mother's name.
- With the Siege of Lordaeron broken, Erilihn Autumnsong and Iradri Ashwalker return to Quel'Thalas with other rangers and soldiers to assist with driving out the remaining Amani trolls and securing elven territory for reconstruction.

Defeat of the Horde –

- The Alliance pushes on all fronts and drives the Horde south.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern leads a contingent of mounted rangers and spellcasters against the Horde as they push through Arathi, and onto the Thandol Span. His forces deal withering blows to the Horde in the narrow mountain passes from above and their exposed sides when crossing the span.
 - Magus Rastanil Goldthorn remains with Ranger-Captain Alleria Windrunner's forces that pursue the Horde south.
 - Noridel Virris at long last joins the front line forces as the Alliance drives the Horde south, rallying troops with battle hymns and tending to the wounded.
 - Ethrian Duskrider journeys south to join the Alliance forces, bringing reinforcements from Quel'Thalas in the form of reconstituted mounted units.




- Returning to her homeland, Iradri Ashwalker faces heartbreak and a deep sense of failure when seeing the full extent of the destruction and death that had befallen Quel'Thalas.
 - The experiences of the war drive her to embrace a merciless approach to war, and shape the opinion that no price would be too steep to ensure the safety of the elven people.
- The mountain city of Ironforge is lifted, and the Bronzebeard Dwarves and gnomes of Gnomeregan, under **King Magni** and **King Mekkatorque**, finally join the war effort against the Horde.
- Vangellis Falwellow pledges himself as a squire to **Sir Daldrick Gravehammer**, one of the Alliance paladins of the Silver Hand, and begins to train under him.
- Horde reinforcements, led by **Dal'rend** and **Maim Blackhand**, attempt to sail to Stormwind from the Tomb of Sargeras, from where they can reinforce **Orgrim's** forces.
 - The Alliance navy, under the command of **Admiral Daelin Proudmoore**, engages them on the high seas with the support of the Wildhammer clan and lays waste to the Horde's fleet.
 - **Derek Proudmoore**, son of **Daelin Proudmoore**, is killed during the Battle of Crestfall, despite the decisive Alliance victory.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough and other elven sorcerers gather in secret for a ritual
 to unmake one of the orc warlocks, seeking to better understand the dark magics commanded
 by the Horde's mystics.
 - The ritual, gruesome and unspeakable, tears the orc's soul apart and unravels its existence entirely, revealing a great deal about the Fel, and even the Void in the process.
- The Alliance marches on the Burning Steppes and lays siege to Blackrock Mountain, last stronghold of **Orgrim's** Horde.
 - Much of the Alliance's forces drive through the mountain passes around the volcanic stronghold, utilizing the Dark Iron Highway as a way to circumvent the Horde's strong defense of the mountain's interior.




- o Magus Rastanii Goldthorn is critically injured during the battle, but recovered, and later returned to Quel'Thalas with other injured soldiers.
- Anduin Lothar's blade is shattered by the orcish warchief and he is then slain by Orgrim Doomhammer himself.
- Turalyon assumes Lothar's place in rallying the Alliance, takes up the shattered blade, and leads the Alliance onwards in the battle. Turalyon reinvigorates Alliance morale and manages to turn the tide in battle.
- The Alliance captures **Orgrim Doomhammer** in battle, along with many of the Horde soldiers, and routs the remaining army driving them south into the Black Morass.

- The Second War Ends -

- The Horde is broken, and its forces route; many flee through the Dark Portal before it is destroyed by **Archmage Khadgar** and an assembly of mages.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough, Akine Standing, and Aradana Dawnfire remain with the Alliance forces until the end of the war, and are present to take part in the destruction of the Dark Portal.
 - The experience of witnessing the presence, and then destruction of a yawning portal bridging two worlds has a profound impact upon the Kirin Tor magus Akme Starsong, one which invokes a renewed interest in further pursuing her research and studies in astromancy.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker aids the Farstriders across southern Quel'Thalas in hunting down the remaining pockets of the Horde's forces, and are noted for putting to death any fighters they located, preferring not to surrender them into Alliance custody in which they would languish in chains.




- family in the wake of the war.
 - O Both his brother and father place blame upon him for the death of his mother, **Ivanna** Quel'dorah, which furthers a rift between the three men.
 - Magister Feanor turns his focus towards the Magisterium of Quel'Thalas and throws himself into his work.
- On the mist-shrouded continent of Pandaria, Emilia Raldari, living, recovering, and training amongst the monks of the Temple of Serenity, finally begins to emerge from the long process of healing.
 - Given more freedom, she begins to travel the lands of Pandaria and learn more of its vast and deep culture. She begins to work alongside the monks in providing aid and counsel to the many villagers spread throughout the continent.
 - Through this process, Emilia Raldari begins to overcome the struggles and trauma of her years in captivity.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough returns to Quel'Thalas and resumes his research, focused and driven by new discoveries made during his battles against the savage Horde.
 - He takes on a new generation of apprentices.
- The Alliance begins to construct internment camps to imprison the orcs on Azeroth, which would be overseen by **Danath Trollbane** of Stromgarde.
 - Iradri Ashwalker is among many who advocate for the execution of the surviving orcs, rather than imprisonment. She, like those many others, would ultimately be in the minority.
 - Gilneas cedes from the Alliance of Lordaeron over disputes regarding the internment camps, and the nation begins to construct the Greymane Wall.



and work to help maintain order and rebuild. During these efforts, Ranger-Captain Kandravia suffers the loss of several rangers to the further ambushes by orcish and Amani remnants.


Boltseeker continue to hunt down the Horde remnants in Quel'Thalas and Lordaeron,

- Vangellis Falwellow continues his training under Sir Daldrick Gravehammer of the Silver Hand, and eventually becomes a proper paladin of the order.
 - He returns to Quel'Thalas as a representative of the order and uses his powers to pursue the task of cleansing Quel'Thalas of any lingering Horde taint specifically the darker magics used by **Gul'dan's** warlocks.
- The survivors of Stormwind return home and begin to rebuild their city and towns.
 - Ethrian Duskrider remains in Stormwind City and aids the humans in the reconstruction of their capital, seeing it as a rare opportunity to learn of the other races in the Alliance.
- In the wake of the war's end, Tirian Felo'dorah takes to training his page, **Yvresse Thas'ban**, in earnest. The two begin to venture out into the wilds, training to read the land and fight and survive.
 - Over time, the two develop a sibling-like bond.
- The Knights of the Blue Lance continue to expand their ranks over the next decade, recruiting and training knights, archers, and other support personnel to serve out their mandate to protect the High Home.
- **Archmage Khadgar** discovers that energies are still bleeding into Azeroth from Draenor and makes the connection that a link is still active between the worlds.



- The Alliance Expedition -

- As the celebrations marking the end of the Second War come to a close, many realize the magnitude of the devastation suffered during the seven year war.
 - **King Anasterian Sunstrider** of Quel'Thalas perceives the Alliance's redirection after the lifting of the Siege of Silvermoon to have been a literal abandonment of the elven nation.
 - Believing the Alliance to have left the Quel'dorei to battle the remaining trolls alone so that they could selfishly liberate Lordaeron, the **King's** resentment towards humanity and the Alliance at large grows.
 - The Silvermoon Magistry meets frequently to discuss Quel'Thalas' involvement and role in the Alliance of Lordaeron, meetings which are often fraught with tension and disagreement. Zalvie Hameblade is present for many of these meetings, though her suggestions and counsel is often dismissed by more senior magisters.
- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, King Anasterian's son, continues his association with the Alliance through his membership within the Kirin Tor despite the growing isolationist attitude being adopted by Quel'Thalas. Many other priests, sorcerers, and paladins likewise continue their association with the Alliance.
- Former Warchief Orgrim Doomhammer escapes his captivity and goes into hiding in the forests of Lordaeron.
- Ner'zhul dispatches some of the remaining servants of the Horde on Draenor to Azeroth, including Teron Gorefiend, Grommash Hellscream, and Kargath Bladefist, all of whom were tasked with retrieving several magical items. This act prompted a strong response from the Alliance.








- Alliance forces break out from the fierce fighting on the steps of the Dark Portal.
 - Magister Feator Queldorah is among the forces that venture southwest of the Dark Portal and carve away more territory from the Horde.
 - The Alliance assaults and destroys the orcish shipyards located at Zeth'kur.
 - The Alliance forces establish Honor Hold as an additional stronghold.
- From their established fortifications, the Sons of Lothar launch a campaign assault against Hellfire Citadel, a massive orcish stronghold in the region.
 - Magister Feator Queldoral and other magi, under the command of Archmage Khadgar, are tasked with scrying and the stars Draenor's magical structures to discern the Horde's google, while also investigating Hellfire Citadel in search of weaknesses and other critical information.
 - General Turalyon and Commander DanathTrollbane continue to direct the Alliance's military forces while preparations are made for a more aggressive campaign.
- Magi forces under Archmage Khadgar discover the Horde's plans under Ner'zhul, and become hard pressed to accelerate their campaign.
- The Sons of Lothar lead an assault on Hellfire Citadel, at the heart of the Tanaan Peninsula, and engage the Shattered Hand forces defending it.
 - Magistrix Tialeth Skyshroud takes part in the assault on Hellfire Citadel, and is nearly slain in battle.
 - During the fighting, Magister Feanor Quel dorah is nearly slain in battle while fighting a veteran warlock of the Shadowmoon Clan, the first clan to have embraced the teachings of Gul'dan before the Horde's first invasion of Azeroth.
 - Given the limited number of soldiers able to be drawn up to defend the Citadel, the Horde's defense collapses, and the Alliance storms the fortress.
 - Despite the Alliance victory, Kargath Bladefirst, leader of the Shattered Hand, and Ner'zhul, now Warchief of the Horde, manage to escape.





- Venturing northwest into Gorgrond, **Archmage Khadgar** and his forces wage war against **Deathwing** and the ebon drakes in his service, and find allies in the leader of the Gronn, **Gruul**, and his followers.
- Commander Danath Trollbane and the dwarven thane Kurdran Wildhammer pursue Ner'zhul in an effort to recover the <u>Book of Medivh</u>, the Last Guardian.
 - Magister Feator Queldorah is among the elven forces dispatched south under the command of **Danath Trollbane**.
 - The Alliance host ventures south into Terokkar Forest and battles back the Horde. In the dense forest, they are subject to frequent ambushes.
 - Thane Kurdran Wildhammer is captured during the days of fighting.
 - Weary from endless days and weeks of fighting, the Alliance forces establish camp in order to recover and rest before pressing on.
- In the dense foliage of Terokkar Forest, Alliance forces under the leadership of **Lieutenant Talthressar**, one of **Ranger-Captain Alleria Windrunner's** rangers, break ground on what later becomes the Allerian Stronghold, a safe haven within the woodlands for all forces of the Alliance.
 - Rested, the Alliance host under **Commander Danath Trollbane** continues on in pursuit of **Ner'zhul**, and the captured thane **Kurdran Wildhammer**.
 - This pursuit leads the Sons of Lothar to the shattered ruins of Auchindoun, the former mausoleum of the Draenei, a place where the remnants of **Gul'dan's** Shadow Council had sought refuge.



- The leadership of the Expedition on Draenor reconvenes, and Alliance forces amass to lay siege to Ner'zhul's fortress in Shadowmoon Valley, the Black Temple.
 - Magister Feator Quel'dorah is among the many elven soldiers, rangers, and magi that take part in the siege.
 - Ner'zhul attempts to open countless portals to other worlds to invade, which begins to tear apart the world of Draenor.
 - Draenor begins to crumble, and **Ner'zhul** escapes through one of the portals.
 - O Desperate to prevent the destruction of the world from spilling over into Azeroth, the Alliance's forces rush back to the Dark Portal with the intent to destroy it.
- Seeking to escape the crumbling world of Draenor, the many surviving orcs throw themselves in a final, desperate assault against the Alliance fortifications around the portal, and the last battle of Draenor begins in earnest.
 - Alliance forces, including Magister Feanor Quel dorah, hold their ground around the base of the portal.
 - Archmage Khadgar uses the Skull of Gul'dan to unwind the magic holding the Dark Portal open. The gateway slams shut, stranding the Expedition's forces on the dying world of Draenor.
- To survive and escape the destruction of the world, many of the Sons of Lothar flee through the otherworldly portals opened by Ner'zhul before his escape.
 - Members of a unit within the Alliance Expedition, under the command of Magistrix Aelaria Vin'arius of Quel'Thalas, flee through one of the portals and find themselves trapped within an anomaly within the Twisting Nether, freezing them in time.





- With the presumed loss of the Alliance Expedition, the rising costs of orcish internment, and believing his debt to **Thoradin's** bloodline to have been paid in full with the event of **Supreme Commander Anduin Lothar's** death, **King Anasterian Sunstrider** withdraws Quel'Thalas from the Alliance.
 - O Disagreeing with the decision to break from the Alliance, Zalvie Flameblade and Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker work to maintain relations with their dwarven and human colleagues, and both venture south, beyond the kingdom's border on occasion to help support the Alliance's work.
 - The departure of Quel'Thalas from the Alliance proves to be a point of contention between Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker and her father, Magister Sallastus Boltseeker.
- Manyssa Blackwood departs Quel'Thalas and ventures out on her own, eager to pursue deeper knowledge of herbalism.
- Survivors of the destruction of Draenor regroup at the shattered stronghold of Honor Hold under Commander Danath Trollbane, Archmage Khadgar, and Thane Kurdran Wildhammer.
 - Magister Feator Quel'dorah is among the many to gather at Honor Hold, and aids the surviving magi under Khadgar in scrying to establish a way back to Azeroth, but to no avail.
- Realizing they are stranded on the ruins of Draenor, now called the Outlands, the Sons of Lothar divide their forces and settle themselves in several areas previously established by the Alliance.
 - Commander Danath Trollbane takes command of many of the human and dwarven soldiers at Honor Hold, in what is now referred to as Hellfire Peninsula.

- In the years after the end of the Second War, Sae'themar Sunfeather and his family work to mend ties and rebuild bridges as they reconstruct the family estate in southeastern Quel'Thalas.
 - O During this time, Sae'themar Sunfeather frequently journeys between Quel'Thalas and Dalaran to remain engaged in worldly magical affairs and knowledge, and utilizes the peacetime calm to further improve his skills and establish himself apart from his family's name.
- In the years following the war's end, Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker, her sister **Auril Emily Dawnbreaker**, and her company of Farstriders journey south to Lordaeron frequently, working to train the Alliance ranger forces that they have served with against the Horde.
 - Repaying the loyalty shown to the elves by the Alliance, the Farstriders work to facilitate more advanced joint force maneuvers, guiding the Alliance archers and riflemen in more effectively supporting their footmen.
- Teremath Crimsonsun graduates from his studies in Silvermoon.
 - Finding little interest in following in his father's footsteps as head of the house, Teremath seeks out a different life apart from the family's affairs. He begins to establish






- She is taken to become the adoptive daughter of this pirate, Ah Abunai Za'vi, a




- The Forming of the Scourge -



- O The family business venture pits Dorian and his parents against a naga sea witch, Rash'jatir, and a cohort of serpentine enforcers who, having already located the sunken tower, have claimed it for themselves. The family devises a plan to steal a powerful talisman from Rash'jatir, to enchant it, and then lure the sea witch out to reclaim it.
- Though the trick works, and **Rash'jatir** strikes out to reclaim the talisman, the enchantment-intended to freeze the witch using a temporal spell-does not hold as long as intended.
- While the family is diving through the sunken tower to locate any valuable artifacts within the structure, **Rash'jatir** and her followers attack the family, and the trio is forced to fight for their lives.
- Only through wit and guile are the elves able to trap **Rash'jatir** and her naga in the tower and escape empty handed.
- The experience fosters a deep sense of excitement in the profession for Dorian, and he begins to more seriously pursue a career within the family business of adventuring.





- Kel'thuzad, a sorcerer of Dalaran, begins to hear the voice of Ner'zhul.
- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider and the other members of Dalaran's Council of Six expel Kel'thuzad from Dalaran due to his perverse studies and experiments.
 - **Kel'thuzad** departs Dalaran and establishes the Cult of the Damned, sworn in service to **Ner'zhul**, the **Lich King**, and the Scourge he aims to create.
 - He lures powerful nobles across Lordaeron to his cause, and takes up residence within Scholomance, a keep in southern Lordaeron, which becomes a school for cultists.
 - Whispers of this cult reach Ara'dana Dawnfire in Quel'Thalas, and she departs her homeland with the intent of seeking out the Cult of the Damned. She is later admitted and begins studying under the fallen mage and his many other followers.
- Varian Wrynn, the young King of Stormwind, marries and is granted an Heir, Anduin Wrynn.
- After learning of a series of raids on the edge of Quel'Thalas' southern border, Ethrian Duskrider takes a contingent of elven mounted rangers south in the human kingdoms of Lordaeron and Arathi to hunt a war band of orcs that survived the Second War, by **Zhar'fang** the Mad a frenzied orc of the Dragonmaw Clan.
 - This hunt leads the elves into a conflict with a ruby dragon still enslaved by the orcs. The mounted spellbows engage in a desperate, frenzied battle against a swarm of dragon whelplings and young drakes, along with their orcish riders.
 - The elves claim victory and put the orcs to death after a prolonged battle. **Zhar'fang the Mad** is killed in the battle high up in the mountains. Many of the dragons are freed and released back into the world.
 - o Ethrian Duskrider leads his spellbows back to Quel'Thalas.
- Quellicia Dawnstar begins her magical studies under the tutelage of private instructors.




• Ary Wynters is married to **Willier Sylaine** in an arranged marriage.

- Ara'dana Dawnfire returns to Quel'Thalas on a mission from the Cult of the Damned, to steal valuable and powerful tomes from one of Silvermoon's many vast archives.
 - Ara'dana is able to use her prior history as one of Silvermoon's many skilled and well regarded magi as a means to gain access to the texts, and steals them from the archives.

Dorian Fallowmarsh inherits his family's rather quirky legacy as he becomes head of his family, responsible for the care of his younger siblings and the family's wealth and


- A former colleague, however, pursues Ara'dana in the hopes of learning where she has been. Believing her secret to have been exposed, preemptively attacks the mage and the two battle in the alleys of Silvermoon. She is scarred by the encounter after suffering an injury, but manages to defeat her former colleague and escape.
- Ara'dana Dawnfire returns to Scholomance in eastern Lordaeron and delivers the stolen elven tomes.
- Cael braen Sunbreeze returns to Quel'Thalas after being contacted by a secretive cohort of magi in Silvermoon who sought to learn of other, darker magics.
 - With their aid, he is able to return to Silvermoon, and learns to conceal his use of fel magic, though he cloisters himself and avoids visiting his family. He works within the cohort to further expand the group's knowledge of darker powers.
- Elinara Sunscryer and Tomil Hopecry arrange a marriage for their daughter, Ellusen Hopecry, to a noble magister of the Kingdom. The practice of arranged marriages is not uncommon in the Hopecry family, and was similarly chosen as the path for Ellusen's older sister Mercura.




- Lordaeronian internment camp. **Thrall** meets with **Orgrim Doomhammer**, once Warchief of the Horde, and secures his blessing to lead the orcish remnants onwards.
 - Together, with the aid of the Frostwolf Clan, the orcs wage a series of bloody battles
 against Alliance forces in Lordaeron and break out the orcs from their internment
 camps.
 - Orgrim Doomhammer is slain during these battles.
 - Thrall comes into contact with **Grommash Hellscream**, another legendary figure of the Horde.
- Rallying the escaped orcs and forging a new Horde, **Thrall** leads the orcs west across the sea to Kalimdor.
- Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar's brother, **Roshan**, is inducted into the Order of the Silver Hand, and her sister, Carinthia, is inducted into the Farstriders around the same time.

- The Fall of Lordaeron -


- The Cult of the Damned, under the leadership and command of **Kel'thuzad**, unleashes the plague in Lordaeron.
 - Ara'dana Dawnfire is one of the many cultists who work feverishly to help spread and perfect the plague. Her pursuits take her to the far east of Lordaeron where she works to help reanimated slain soldiers in the southern towns of far eastern Lordaeron.
- Vangellis Falwellow ventures south into Lordaeron with other clerics to aid the humans in addressing and countering the spreading plague. Tyrannea Lightharte is also present amongst the elven clerics, only twenty years of age and not yet a fully anointed priestess. The group endeavors to aid those sick with the plague.
 - The Quel'dorei clerics in Lordaeron are able to save many, evacuating those who can walk and travel, though they face mounting, and then impossible odds against the fast spread of the plague.



- The Northgate Rebellion breaks out in Gilneas as the people trapped north of the Greymane Wall revolt against the **Genn Greymane's** decision to seal off Gilneas from Lordaeron and refuse to aid during the outbreak of the plague.
- Though in the Lordaeron region at the time, Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker and her sister **Auril Emily Dawnbreaker** remain far removed from the ongoing crisis in Lordaeron, and continue training Alliance forces in joint force fighting.
- Quel'Thalas remains isolated from the Alliance, and tightens security at its borders.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough grows disillusioned with the politics of Silvermoon's ruling elite.
- The Scourge rises as a threat to the living.
 - The Scourge razes Lordaeron, bringing humanity to its knees.
 - O Prince Arthas Menethil and Sir Uther the Lightbringer, first of the paladins of the Silver Hand, are dispatched by King Terenas Menethil II to investigate the plague and seek an end to it. They first encounter the Scourge and begin an effort to battle back the undead throughout the region with the support of Jaina Proudmoore of Kul Tiras, also a skilled sorceress of Dalaran.
 - o It is discovered that plagued grain is responsible for the spread of the plague.
 - Prince Arthas Menethil and Jaina Proudmoore confront and slay Kel'thuzad, leader of the Cult of the Damned, and pursue the individual they believe to be guiding the necromancer's hand, one of the Nathrezim known as Mal'ganis.
- It is discovered that shipments of plagued grain have already reached the city of Stratholme, in eastern Lordaeron.
- Vangellis Falwellow narrowly survives the initial outbreak, and withdraws with other Silver Hand forces to one of several strongholds which are fortified against the undead.



- Numerous merchant ships fleeing Lordaeron with survivors attempt to land in Quel'Thalas, and both Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Commander Zandayn Starbreeze are ordered to intercept and divert the vessels, and to sink any that refuse.
 - Aboard the *Silverspell* and *Dawning Sword*, both captains reluctantly comply with their orders and intercept roughly a dozen ships.
 - Commander Zandayn Starbreeze, though issuing protest on the record, gives the order to sink *Pale Empress* and *Twin Zions*, two Lordaeronian merchant vessels that refused to divert course.
 - Records gathered from the ship's logs of *Dawning Sword* claim that roughly four dozen souls were last spotted adrift on wreckage some fourteen leagues west of the Thalassian coast on the southern quarter raised latitude with winds bearing south-southwest, indicating that survivors would likely drift back towards Lordaeron.
- **Prince Arthas Menethil** of Lordaeron leads an expedition to Northrend in pursuit of the Nathrezim **Mal'ganis** the individual believed to be responsible for setting loose the Scourge.
- After word of the emergence of the Scourge reaches Quel'Thalas in earnest, Ellusen Hopecry is sent north, to the Isle of Quel'Danas by her family, fearing her to be too ill to survive should the plague spread north into Quel'Thalas.
 - She travels to Quel'Danas with a collective of priestesses.



- After escaping the Emerald Dream, **Ralaar Fangfire** and his fellow worgen establish the Wolf Cult, a dedicated following of cursed worgen who seek to spread the influence of their curse, and to take revenge on **Archdruid Malfurion Stormrage** for imprisoning them ages past.
 - This cult spreads throughout the ruins of Lordaeron and Gilneas, and also as far south as the Duskwood region of the kingdom of Stormwind.
 - Under **Ralaar Fangfire's** leadership, this cult seeks out the <u>Scythe of Elune</u>.
- **Jaina Proudmoore** leads the survivors of humanity west to Kalimdor, including numerous Quel'dorei clerics and magi, and establishes the city of Theramore.
- Many elves, including Colben Ornae and Vangellis Falwellow, return to Quel'Thalas in anticipation of the Scourge's advance.
- Prince Arthas Menethil, now champion of the Lich King, returns to Lordaeron and murders his father King Terenas Menethil II, and then razes the kingdom of Lordaeron.
 - The surviving humans in Lordaeron are hunted to the brink of extinction, and many flee south or west. Stormwind becomes a central hub for refugees fleeing the Scourge, a generosity which repays the debt owed to Lordaeronians by Stormwind for their aid during the First and Second Wars.
- Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar returns to Quel'Thalas with her family to attend the wedding of a cousin.
- Apprentice Hespir Everwyern is dispatched to the southern regions of Quel'Thalas in pursuit of a supposed ruined sanctum on the western shores of the kingdom.
 - He and several other apprentices become trapped in the ruined sanctum and uncover the ghost of a Highborne sorcerer who served under **Queen Azshara** before the

Sundering. They learn of how he died during the cataclysmic end of the War of the Ancients, and are able to unlock much of the sorcerer's knowledge. With their task completed, they begin their journey into northern Quel'Thalas.

• Erilihn Autumnsong continues her duties with the Farstriders in northeastern Quel'Thalas.

• In Quel'Thalas, Lord Mordrathan Skyshman prepares to dispatch a contingent of his family members into the southern human kingdoms to discern the true extent of the plague, and to verify the claims of the reanimated dead having taken hold of the kingdom.

• He faces stiff resistance from his family members, notably one of the only times his leadership is questioned by his descendents.

• Heeding their words, though, he refrains from dispatching anyone to the south, and instead begins to prepare the estate for the likelihood of refugees venturing north into

the elven realm.


- The Invasion of Quel'Thalas -

- Prince Arthas Menethil, now a death knight
 in service to the Lich King, reaches out to
 Dar'Khan Drathir in Quel'Thalas, a magister
 of the Kingdom whose resentment for his own
 people's nobility stemmed from his lack of
 higher appointment.
 - O Dar'Khan assists Arthas Menethil in the despoiling of Quel'Thalas by murdering several members of the Convocation of Silvermoon, interupting the spell connecting the Sunwell to Ban'dinoriel, the barrier protecting and shielding the elven nation from the world beyond its borders.
 - As a result, the Scourge is able to march upon the far edges of the kingdom.
 - **Dar'Khan** also provides information to **Prince Arthas** about the Elfgates barring the way into the inner reaches of Quel'Thalas.


- Elven rangers harass and harry the undead armies, striking from the cover of the trees
 and hills that line the pass. The Scourge suffer volley after volley of arrow and spell as
 they advance, and resorting to blighting the land in order to drive out the elven
 ambushers.
- Sylvanas Windrunner, Ranger General of Quel'Thalas and commander of the Farstriders, takes charge of the defense of the kingdom and coordinates a thorough defense of the southern gatehouse within the Thalassian Pass. There, the Scourge are bottlenecked and whittled down.
 - After costly delays, Scourge meat wagons and other siege engines are brought forth and used to demolish the gatehouse.
 - **Sylvanas** and her rangers, among whom Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker is counted, withdraw deeper into the woodland and continue to harry the Scourge's endless forces, buying time for the kingdom's armies to prepare.
- Apprentice Chellicia Dawnstar and many of her family members withdraw to a family estate in the western regions of Silvermoon City to take shelter and hide.
- Magistrix Zyellia Bloodsong remains in Silvermoon City during the initial advance of the Scourge in the far south.
- Well-Watcher Nadrassa Skyshwood remains on the Isle of Quel'Danas and aids in preparations to defend the Sunwell Plateau.
- Many Quel'dorei join the fight to save their homeland, the defense of which is organized and led by Ranger General Sylvanas Windrunner, Grand Magister Belo'vir Salonar, King Anasterian Sunstrider, and other Quel'dorei of great renown.
 - Apprentice Hespir Everwyen, along with the other apprentices he had been traveling with, are stranded in the far southern woodlands of Quel'Thalas, and struggle to survive against the unanticipated Scourge invasion. They venture east to a ranger lodge,



- to the capital and tasked with guarding the gates and walls of Silvermoon.
- Ethrian Duskrider supports the defense of Quel'Thalas against the Scourge, operating once again as commander of mounted spellbows who harass and harry the undead's flanks.
- Lord Mordrathan Skyshroud supports the defense of Quel'Thalas against the Scourge, leading his kin, including Magistrix Gladarhan Skyshroud, battlemage Daine Skyshroud, and Magistrix Soren'adal Skyshroud, in battle. They work to defend the southern regions of the kingdom. They are slowly driven north.
- is dispatched to aid in the defense of Windrunner Village. Along the way, he narrowly survives a deadly and brutal ambush by gargoyles and ghouls.
- Zariasona Emberspirit joins her family and others, including Aelor and Zalvie Flameblack, in preparing to defend the capital city, Silvermoon, against the Scourge's advance.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough is dispatched to the southern reaches of Eversong Forest, and is tasked with securing magical sanctums and vaults in order to protect powerful artifacts from capture. In the fierce battles he fights, he suffers the loss of his entire cadre of apprentices, something which deeply affects the Master Sorcerer.
- Vynlorin Shandaumath and his mentor, Lord Darkterror, join the defense of Quel'Thalas in the south. Anticipating future waves of undead, he and his mentor slowly journey north and battle the Scourge along the way.
- Llyreth Starseeker and Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker take part in the defense of Quel'Thalas against the Scourge. They both fight beside the Farstriders to hold back the Scourge in the southern regions.




- Obspite inflicting a high rate of attrition upon the Scourge's living summoners and forces, each death ultimately only supplements the Scourge's forces as necromancers reanimate the fallen without pause. Ara'dana Dawnfire is one of the many necromancers who work ceaselessly to reanimate the dead.
- Once through the first Elfgate, **Arthas** and the Scourge carve a deep path of death and destruction through southern Quel'Thalas and advance towards the second Elfgate.
- The Scourge spreads out across the woodlands south and southwest of the Elrendar River and the undead begin striking out at the elven settlements.
- Duskwatch Village, a southern settlement, is one of the first townships in Quel'Thalas proper to be razed by the Scourge.
 - The few defenders present are killed to the last, with the bulk of its soldiers already having left to delay the Scourge's advance further south and east.
 - With the first and only township along the way to Thas'alah–the Mother Tree of Quel'Thalas–now erased, the Scourge advance on the ancient and sacred grounds.
- The Scourge assault and kill the defenders of Thas'alah and cut down the Mother Tree.
 - They begin to establish fortifications around the fallen tree, and begin construction on the Scourge Citadel known as Deatholme.
- With an initial foothold established, the Scourge spreads across the southern half of Quel'Thalas and advances on numerous other settlements.
 - O Several Death Knights lead a strike force west and lay siege to the Windrunner Village, torching the woodlands along the outskirts and blighting the land to enrage the elves. The bait works, and the township's defenders emerge to drive out the Scourge, leaving themselves vulnerable to the overwhelming numbers brought forth by the undead.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong's parents, **Visette** and **Galuin Autumnsong**, are slain by the Scourge in Windrunner Village.




- Halduron Brightwing leads a company of rangers south to counter the Scourge.
 - o Included amongst their number is Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong.

shadow and fire magics upon the elven defenders she is compelled to fight.

- Magistrix Goldran Starbucze aids in the defense of the southern regions, but eventually withdraws to one of the sanctums belonging to the Elrendar Fellowship, just east of the Sanctum of the Sun.
- Lord Mordenthan Skyshroud journeys to the township of Tranquillien and works to prepare its defenses while other members of the Skyshroud family travel to the Sanctum of the Moon to aid in its defense.
- The Sanctum of the Moon is next assaulted by the Scourge.
 - O A desperate battle is fought by the elven defenders seeking to hold back the undead until the last of the surviving refugees from the nearby hamlets and townships are evacuated. Present and involved in the battle are Vangellis Falwellow, Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker, Ethrian Duskrider, battlemage Daine Skyshroud, Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud, and Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough, among many others.
 - The Sanctum of the Moon is abandoned by the elven defenders, and the surviving forces withdraw north to Tranquillien, the largest town south of the Elrendar River.
 - Ethrian Duskrider is ordered north to assist the Farstriders in preparing for the coming defense of Silvermoon City.
 - o Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern leads mounted spellbows and sorcerers west from the Farstrider Enclave, seeking to reinforce the Sanctum of the Sun and the eastern roads. With the bulk of the Scourge's vanguard already further north along the road, he and his forces are able to strike heavy blows against the undead army's flanks.




- Acting on information provided by Dar'Khan Drathir, Arthas seeks out the three crystals
 necessary to forge the <u>Key of the Three Moons</u>, an artifact necessary to breach the second
 Elfgate.
 - Arthas' forces assault the three temples housing the crystals, An'daroth, An'telas, and An'owyn.
 - The elven defenders **Koltira**, **Faltora**, and **Merriel** are slain defending An'owyn from **Thassarian**, one of **Prince Arthas'** powerful death knights.
 - **Koltira** is raised as one of the first Darkfallen, elves raised in service to the Scourge. He bonds with **Thassarian** in undeath, despite the human being his killer.
- Ranger Lord Lor'themar Theron and a company of rangers under his command arrive at An'daroth, one of the temples used to house the crystals of the <u>Key of the Three Moons</u>, only to discover they are too late to aid in its defense.
 - The recently reanimated elves that had once defended the temple ambush the Ranger Lord and his forces, and Lor'themar Theron is severely wounded in the fighting. As a result, the Ranger Lord loses his eye, and his forces are nearly massacred.
 - Halduron Brightwing arrives with reinforcements, including Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong and many other Farstriders, and is able to rescue the Ranger Lord. They depart and return north towards Silvermoon City.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong departs from **Halduron Brightwing's** company and aids nearby stragglers to evacuate their township.
 - The Ranger-Lieutenant then travels to Windrunner village, only to find their home and family destroyed.
 - Erilihn withdraws to Tranquillien, where they prepare to aid in the defense of the settlement under the command of **Ranger General Sylvanas Windrunner**.
- With the three crystals in hand, **Prince Arthas** forges the <u>Key of the Three Moons</u> and breaches the second Elfgate.




- Members of the Elrendar Fellowship activate the enchanted wards on their sanctum, sealing the vault entirely and preventing its capture and exploitation by the Scourge.
 The magi then escape the sanctum through its secret entrance.
- The defenders of Quel'Thalas, including Lord Mordnathan Skyshroud, Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud, Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker, Baranthore Sunstriker, battlemage Daine Skyshroud, and Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong, hold the Scourge at bay during the siege of Tranquillien under the command of Sylvanas Windrunner.

within its halls, among which is Magistrix Geldiran Starbreeze.

- Flamebringer Soren, the skeletal mage once known as Magistrix Soren'adal Skyshmoul, is part of the assault force dispatched by the Scourge to destroy the township of Tranquillien. Her former kin confront her, and put her to rest after a harrowing battle.
- The defenders of Tranquillien are eventually forced to withdraw further north towards the river crossing.
 - O Ara'dana Dawnfire is slain by the elven defenders of Tranquillien, and subsequently raised into undeath by one of the more powerful necromancers of the Scourge. Embracing undeath as a release from the shackles of mortality, Ara'dana begins to fall deeper and deeper into darkness, becoming twisted and depraved, far more than she ever was when living. She takes up the surname Dreadflame.
- The township of Goldenmist Village is razed by the Scourge.
- Aegis, the family enclave of the Hopecry family, is razed by the Scourge.
 - The family's many members, mostly healers, are slain by the Scourge.



- The Farstrider Enclave in the south eastern regions of the Eversong Forest is destroyed by the Scourge.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern and his brother, Apprentice Hespir Everwyern, strike north with a band of other survivors. They travel along the eastern edges of Lake Elrendar, and follow its northern river branch to the Farstrider Retreat just south of Silvermoon City.
- The Scourge pursues elven refugees north along the eastern edges of Quel'Thalas; they also continue to engage the scattered Amani populations lingering outside Zul'Aman.
 - The Scourge assault and then raze Dawnstar Village, and the nearby Dawnstar Spire.
- The Scourge advances across the Elrendar Crossing and assaults the inner holdings of the Kingdom of Quel'Thalas.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong and Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker continue to fight alongside the defenders of Quel'Thalas, under the command of Ranger General Sylvanas Windrunner, as their forces are pushed further north.
 - The Scourge attempts to assault the Sunsail Anchorage by utilizing a narrow mountain pass, but are bottlenecked and held at bay by the defenders, including Ranger-Lieutenant Braeden Starbreeze.
 - Both Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Commander Zandayn Starbreeze return to the Sunsail Anchorage aboard their ships, *Silverspell* and *Dawning Sword*, and join their extended family and the port's many defenders in holding the Scourge at bay.
 - Magi, artillery handlers, and rangers aboard Silverspell and Dawning Sword unleash an
 unceasing barrage of magic and missiles upon the undead, aiding the efforts to hold
 them back.
- The township of Fairbreeze Village is razed by the Scourge, enabling the Scourge's advance west towards the Sunsail Anchorage from a new direction.




- The Scourge advances further north and crosses the river heading west.
 - The Scourge assault and then raze the West Sanctum.

- Aeydark Bal'annor and many other defenders withdraw to Silvermoon City.
- The remaining elven defenders in the northern half of Quel'Thalas are forced to withdraw towards Silvermoon City.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough and Magistrix Goldiran Starbreeze teleport back to Silvermoon City and work to support the defenders in preparing for the coming siege.

Ranger-Lieutenant Braeden Starbreeze is slain while defending the township of

- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth works to aid the Magisters in activating magical sentries and erecting wards throughout the city, providing areas for defenders to use as holdouts in case of the walls being breached.
- Magistrix Geldian Starbreeze works to open portals throughout the city, offering a method of rapid transportation for the defenders.
- The townships of Falconwing and Starseeker Village are razed by the Scourge.
- Commander Venthar Starbreeze, commanding the elven destroyer Silverspell, sails south to in the defense of the city, and if needed, the evacuation of its people.






- In the wake of Ranger General Sylvanas Windrunner's death, Grand Magister Belo'vir Salonar assumes command of the defense of Silvermoon City.
- Ellahora Emberlight barely survives the onslaught of the Scourge outside the city, safeguarded only by her older sister **Velare**. They secure a position within Silvermoon and attempt to wait out the fighting.
- Many of the surviving elven defenders rally to the defense of Silvermoon City against the Scourge's relentless assault, including Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough, r, Althenar Sunstriker, Lord Mor'drathan Skyshroud, Cael'braen Sunbreeze, Vangellis Falwellow, Magistrix Geldiran Starbreeze, Colben Ornae, Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker, Ethrian Duskrider, Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong, Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud, Captain Zandayn Starbreeze, and Llyreth Starseeker.
- O Vynlorin Shandaumath's parents, his aunt, and his uncle are slain by the Scourge in southern Quel'Thalas.
- Ary Wynters is caught just outside the city as the Scourge force their advance. They are knocked unconscious in the scramble to get back into the city.
- Aelor and Zalvie Flameblade are split up inside the city as they work to gather civilians islands off the western coast of the mainland, and evacuate civilians out of the city.






- Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong and Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker
 fight to defend the city against the undead, and serve under the command of
 Halduron Brightwing, one of the two acting leaders of the Farstriders in the wake of
 Ranger General Sylvanas Windrunner's death.
- Aeydark Bal'annor seeks out his wife and parents within the city and tries to evacuate
 them, though his parents are separated in the scramble. He is able to evacuate his wife,
 Camilia Haven, on horseback before journeying into the western half of the city to
 hold the defenses.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker's mother, **Lysendra Silverblossom**, is slain defending the city.
- O Cael'braen Sunbreeze and the cohort of dark sorcerers he had developed close ties with battle against the Scourge in the city, but many are slain in battle. Cael'braen Sunbreeze captures the souls of the fallen sorcerers and consumes their power for himself.
- O Zariasona Emberspirit and her mother are separated from the rest of their family within the city, and return only in time to witness the deaths of her sisters and father at the hands of the Scourge. During their escape from the brutal scene, Zariasona suffers various injuries that scar and pesist.
- The parents of Ary Wynters are killed by the Scourge inside the city.
- Ary Wynters and her husband, Willier Sylaine, manage to barely survive the onslaught and escape.
- Lord Thiodrus Leafson, mentor to General Iradri Ashwalker, is slain defending Silvermoon City.
- Ven'rallei Stormingdawn manages to survive the Scourge's onslaught, but suffers the loss of his family.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough, Magistrix Goldinan Starbrecze, and Althenar Sunstriker battle the Scourge in the city's eastern districts, ceding ground bit




• Aeydark Bal'annor is slain defending the western districts of Silvermoon City.

the undead while others flee to safety.

- Ethrian Duskrider is forced into the western districts of Silvermoon City, and eventually driven out through the western gate. He and other survivors form a line of defense at the bridge connecting the city's western entrance to Sunstrider Isle.
- The Scourge assaults the Sunfury Spire, the throne and seat of power of the Sunstrider Dynasty in Quel'Thalas.
- Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar and her cousins are evacuated from the besieged capital city and taken south, by ship, along the coasts. They are ferried to South Shore, in southern Lordaeron.
- Archmage Idris Dawnstar, father of Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar, manages to escape the fall of Silvermoon.
- Three elven merchant ships depart from Silvermoon ferrying survivors, children included, seeking to flee the kingdom. The ships, *Morn'danel*, *Fellovar*, and *Varillian*, travel south along the eastern coast of Quel'Thalas, but are intercepted and sunk by the Scourge.
- Magistrix Zyellia Bloodsong leads her retainers and guards outside the city walls in search of her father, Lord Daenir Bloodsong, who had been fighting on the frontlines.
 - They are witness to his corpse being dragged away by the Scourge to be reanimated.
 - Magistrix Zyellia Bloodsong, now head of the Bloodsong family with the confirmed death of her father, leads her retainers and guards against the Scourge in an effort to recover Lord Daenir Bloodsong's body.
 - Many of the retainers and guards are slain in the battle, which becomes an outright slaughter with the Scourge overwhelming the elves.



- O Llyreth Starseeker escapes the fall of Silvermoon City, and soon after learns of the deaths of his mother, brothers, and other family members presumably at the hands of the Scourge. He later learns that his brothers were slain during the battle by a distant cousin blinded by ambition, and not the Scourge.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker escapes the fall of Silvermoon City and flees south, seeking to make her way to Dalaran where she might be able to find her father who served as an emissary to the Kirin Tor.
- O Dorian Fallowmarsh leads his three younger siblings to safety during the fall of Silvermoon using a system of underground tunnels used by his family (and several rare goods merchants) to transport rare items and goods in and out of the city. Dorian leads his siblings west, to the Sunsail Anchorage, where their escape is aided by the Farstriders.
- Zariasona Emberspirit and her mother escape the fall of Silvermoon and survive in the outskirts of the crumbling city.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough and Magistrix Geldican Starbouxe are separated from Althenar Sunstriker during the fighting. Althenar Sunstriker escapes the fall of Silvermoon and regroups with the other surviving defenders under Magister Rommath.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong, Cael'braen Sunbreeze, and Magister Lontheril Flameblade—father of Zalvie Flameblade—are among the many to withdraw to the Isle of Quel'Danas in preparation for the Scourge's further advances.
- O Unable to escape the city, Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough, Magistrix Goldinan Starbreeze, and several other magi make a final stand in one of the ruined




- **Sylvanas Windrunner's** body is separated and placed into a locked iron coffin as an act of vengeance for the ranger's defiant stand against the Scourge in life.
- The Farstrider Retreat, south east of Silvermoon City, at long last comes under siege, one of the last remaining holdouts.
 - There, Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas and Apprentice Hespit Iverwyern join other Farstriders and magi in defending the enclave.

- Vynlorin Shandaumath and his mentor **Lord Darkterro**r, upon learning of the destruction of Silvermoon, journey south once more to seek out Vynlorin's family.
 - Vynlorin Shandaumath learns of his parents' death at the hands of the Scourge.




- Quel'danas, home to the Sunwell.

 O This is accomplished by use of unholy frost magics, wielded by **Arthas Menethil** to
 - This is accomplished by use of unholy frost magics, wielded by **Arthas Menethil** to freeze the water and enable his army's crossing.
 - O Led by Grand Magister Belo'vir Salonar and King Anasterian Sunstrider, renowned Quel'dorei rangers, magi, priests, and soldiers stage a last stand on the Isle, including Althenar Sunstriker, Rowan Starbreeze, Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong, battlemage Daine Skyshroud, Well-Watcher Nadrassa Skyshroud, the noble brothers Solanar and Falon, High Priestess Liadrin, Rommath, High Priest Vandellor, ans Magister Lontheril Flameblade—the father of Zalvie Flameblade, along with many others.
- **Grand Magister Belo'vir Salonar** engages **Arthas** in battle, though he is dismembered by the Prince and left to be torn apart by the Scourge.
 - High Priest Vandellor and High Priestess Liadrin attempt to rescue the Grand Magister, though Vandellor is struck down and torn apart by one of the many abominations crafted by the Scourge.
 - O Seeing complete a pact he made with **High Priest Vandellor** some time before, the **Grand Magister** teleports **Liadrin** away with his last breaths before he is slain by the undead. His apprentice, **Magister Rommath**, would later succeed him as Grand Magister.
- Anasterian Sunstrider, the King of Quel'Thalas, engages Arthas in single combat.
 - Anasterian's high elven runeblade Felo'melorn, an heirloom of the Sunstrider dynasty, is shattered during the battle by Arthas' runeblade Frostmourne.
 - Arthas Menethil, fallen prince of Lordaeron and now champion death knight of the Scourge, murders King Anasterian Sunstrider.
 - The king is survived by his son, **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider**, who resides within Dalaran.




- Well-Watcher Madrussa Skyshroud is slain defending the gates to the Plateau. Her body is burned by defenders as they retreat, preventing her reanimation.
- Arthas' forces proceed further inland and take control of the Sunwell Plateau.
 - The elven brothers **Solanar** and **Falon** recover the corpse of the fallen king **Anasterian Sunstrider**, as well as the shattered pieces of his blade, <u>Felo'melorn</u>, and bring him to a secure area of Silvermoon City that had been reclaimed. This act most notably spared the king a fate of undeath.
 - Baranthore Sunstriker manages to fight his way to the body of Althenar Sunstriker and burns the body, preventing his kin from being raised into undeath.
 - Rowan Starbreeze is slain defending the Sunwell, and then raised into undeath by the Scourge. She becomes one of the San'layn.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong and battlemage Daine Skyshroud survive the final routing of the elven defenders and regroup with other rangers under Halduron Brightwing.
 - In the midst of the fighting within the Sunwell Plateau, Ellusen Hopecry is knocked unconscious, but subsequently evacuated from the stronghold by other survivors who flee.
 - Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Commander Zandayn Starbreeze once again evacuate the surviving elves they can from danger, taking scores of wounded soldiers and civilians aboard *Silverspell* and *Dawning Sword* and ferrying them to islands along the coast.
- The Sunwell is tainted as **Prince Arthas** uses the immense powers of the well to resurrect **Kel'thuzad** as a Lich.
- Ellusen Hopecry, still unconscious, is taken on board a fishing boat which sails away from the Isle of Quel'Danas.



• The Stone of Flame and the Stone of Light are stolen from the ruins of the Magister's Terrace by the undead **Dar'Khan Drathir**, and taken south into the blighted forests of Quel'Thalas.

raised into undeath. He is forced into servitude as a slave of the Scourge.

- The stones are placed in the twin structures straddling the Dead Scar, the Bleeding Ziggurat and the Howling Ziggurat.
- In the days immediately following the destruction of the Sunwell and the sacking of Silvermoon and Quel'Thalas, the Scourge turns its focus towards consolidating its gains and raising the dead.
 - **High Priest Vandellor**, who was slain defending the late **Grand Magister Belo'vir** on the Isle of Quel'Danas, is raised into undeath by the Scourge.
 - Sylvanas Windrunner-recently raised into undeath as a banshee herself-raises the fallen Farstrider Ranger Velonara into undeath, making her one of the first Dark Rangers.
 - Ellusen Hopecry awakens aboard an abandoned fishing boat off the coast of Quel'Thalas. After making landfall she is discovered by a company of Farstriders who take her to safety at the secluded sanctum of Magister Vrithis Lightburn, on Lamplight Isle, where she is able to recover.
- **Dar'Khan Drathir**, the betrayer of Quel'Thalas, is given lordship over the undead stronghold Deatholme in southern Quel'Thalas.
 - Hunted by survivors, **Dar'Khan** is branded a traitor, and condemned to death.
- Apprentice Hespir Everwyern and the other apprentices he had been traveling with escape southeast into the Amani mountains, intent on waiting out the worst of the violence.
- With their task and the despoiling of Quel'Thalas now complete, **Arthas**, the resurrected **Lich Kel'thuzad**, and the bulk of the undead Scourge turn south, intending to return to Lordaeron.




It is estimated that, in the wake of the Kingdom's fall, only some fifteen thousand Quel'dorei survive, a mere tenth of the hundred-plus thousand elves living in Quel'Thalas before the Scourge's invasion.

It must be noted that, for the purposes of this chronicle, out of respect for those slain defending Quel'Thalas—the common home for all of high elven blood, the names listed below are the chosen identities of those raised into undeath against their will, and may not be similar to the names they held in life. Understand that this list is by no means exhaustive, and will be revised well in the future as the fates of those still unknown are uncovered.


- O Notable among the slain Farstriders who are raised to be Dark Rangers are Captain Areiel, and rangers Alina, Anya Eversong, Braeden Starbreeze, Clea, Cyndia, Denyelle, Jess, Kalira, Kitala Starshadow, Lenara, Loralen, Lyana, Lelyias, Marrah, Thyala, Vorel, Vor'athil, Thandel, and Zanra, among many others.
- O Notable among the slain soldiers who are raised to become Death Knights are Keritose Bloodbane, Lady Alistra, Andinthe Sunstriker, Azereki Ashenblade, Caladon Leechblade, Jayde, Orin Grimblade, Sylalleas Frostwind, Aeydark Bal'annor, Sylvie Fallensong, Duchess Fallensong, Danir Emberlight, Libbiara Blightrunner, Arachni Bloodseeker, Vik Mournblade, Mor'in, Eran Droll, Lllanna Dreadmoore, Bloodrose Datura, Duchess Mynx, Nethos, Sapph, Baron Silver, and Raevyn Sorrowblade, Vitalia Sunrunner, and Vynlorin Shandaumath's uncle, Vorathien Shandaumath.
- Notable among the slain defenders who are raised to become high ranking San'layn are
 the noble Blood-Princes Tenris Mirkblood, Taldaram, Dreven, Valanar, Sandoval,
 Navarius, Atherann, Theraldis, Blood-Princess Thal'ena, and Blood-Lord
 Vorath; other, though lesser ranking San'layn include Prince Atherann, and also



- The elven people begin to congregate and regroup in the wake of the Kingdom's fall, and new directions are discussed. The elven people, however, are divided on which approach to take.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Sabariel Elizabeth Dawnbreaker and her sister **Auril Emily Dawnbreaker** return to Quel'Thalas, having been traveling north since hearing of the invasion.
 - They fight through the undead and reach Silvermoon City, where they find their parents dead. The two fight to rid their estate of the undead, and come to find their older brother, **Magister Arthanal Alexander Dawnbreaker**, who had fought in and survived the Fall.
 - The return of his sisters is met with hostility, and blame for the two not having been present to defend the family, and the homeland.
 - Faced with more approaching undead, Magister Arthanal teleports the siblings away from Quel'Thalas, to the Quel'lithien lodge, from where they then go their separate ways.
- Some elven survivors flee Quel'Thalas, desperate to escape the savage undead that now roam the kingdom.
 - Llyreth Starseeker travels south, and joins a group of refugees traveling to the human kingdom of Stormwind.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern, Ethrian Duskrider, and Master Sorcerer
 Ansinosth Summerbough depart Quel'Thalas along with many other survivors after
 the fall of the Kingdom. They travel south towards the western coasts of Lordaeron.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Fel'tharanas Everwyern and Ethrian Duskrider link up with Vereesa Windrunner and join her forces in Dalaran.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough leads survivors even further along the coasts and is subsequently discovered by remnant Alliance forces who are preparing to depart for the western continent, known as Kalimdor, to follow Lady Jaina Proudmoore.



- O Ellusen Hopecry, still sheltering at **Magister Vrithis Lightburn's** secluded arcane sanctum, is reunited with her betrothed, the man she had been arranged to marry before the Scourge's invasion. Despite relying on each other in the immediate wake of the Fall, concerning signs foster a sense of unease towards the man for Ellusen.
- Zariasona Emberspirit's mother struggles to cope with the devastating losses suffered
 during the Fall, and begins to shut herself away. She begins to lose her credibility as a
 magus amongst the Quel'dorei.
- Sae'themar Sunfeather is among the many magi who remain in Quel'Thalas, Silvermoon specifically, and work to rebuild and provide relief to the survivors.
- Cael'braen Sunbreeze continues to draw upon fel energy to sustain himself and power his magic; he continues to maintain his use of the Fel in secret, only. As a result, he does not suffer the withering effects that most Quel'dorei do in the wake of the Sunwell's destruction.
- Vangellis Falwellow and other survivors fight their way back towards Silvermoon City and set to work supporting the defense and reconstruction effort there.
- Apprentice Hespir Everwyern and the other surviving apprentices flee the Amani mountains and return to the ruins of Silvermoon City where they find other survivors.
- Ellusen Hopecry learns of the deaths of her family, who had stayed at the Hopecry family enclave, the Aegis. While the entirety of her family is killed, only one cousin, **Vitalia Sunrunner**, is raised into undeath.
- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider returns to Quel'Thalas from Dalaran and surveys the destruction of his kingdom.
 - **Prince Kael'thas** recovers the stolen moon crystals bound to the inner Elfgate on his way north through the kingdom.




having preferred to live instead in Dalaran with the Kirin Tor.

- Ellisen Hopecry, facing a realization in the wake of the Fall, comes to accept that she had not yet proved herself worthy of having survived. She opens a clinic within the ruined capital of Silvermoon, along the avenue known as Murder Row, and provides her skills as a healer to other survivors.
- Archmage Idris Dawnstar, father of Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar, decides to depart from Quel'Thalas in the wake of the Fall. He journeys south with other magisters, bitter over the new path chosen by the Prince and those seeking to call themselves Sin'dorei.
- Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong ultimately decides to stay in Quel'Thalas under **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider**, and works to aid in the reconstruction of the kingdom as one of the Sin'dorei.

In total, it is estimated that of the some fifteen thousand surviving elves, some thirteen and a half thousand pledge themselves to **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** as Sin'dorei, leaving just a little under one and a half thousand elves who still identify at Quel'dorei.


- **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** elects to destroy the tainted Sunwell, saving the nation from the spread of corrupt magics seeping out from it.
 - The Prince leads a coordinated assault on the Isle of Quel'Danas. He is joined by many of the surviving heroes who fought during the Scourge's initial invasion, including the brothers Falon and Solanar, as well as Magister Rommath, Astalar Bloodsworn, Ranger Lord Lor'themar Theron, Halduron Brightwing, Galell, Lady Liadrin, Baranthore Sunstriker, battlemage Daine Skyshroud, and others.
 - While assaulting the Isle, **High Priestess Liadrin** is confronted by the recently raised, undead former **High Priest Vandellor**, her adoptive father. The two engage one another in battle, and **Liadrin** strikes him down.





- O During their efforts to complete the ritual they are attacked, and Falon is slain defending Magister Rommath.
- The spell is completed, and the act severs the elves' connection to the powers of the well.
- Kael'thas retains possession of the three moon crystals and transforms them into Verdant Spheres which are soaked with the power of the Sunwell, artifacts which he uses to empower his magic.
 - o A large volume of first hand accounts report that they are frequently seen bound in a small orbit above the **Prince's** head.
- Lord Solanar, distraught over the death of his brother, abandons his family name and adopts the new surname Bloodwrath. He ascends as one of Prince Kael'thas' chief lieutenants, becoming widely known as Lord Solanar Bloodwrath.
- The Sin'dorei begin to succumb to withdrawal and turn to siphoning mana crystals to stave off the miserable effects of withering.
 - Vynlorin Shandaumath is one of the many elves who suffers from the effects of withdrawal. Regardless, he continues to use his powers to safeguard survivors in the south of Quel'Thalas.
 - Ranger-Lieutenant Erilihn Autumnsong and Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker, as rangers who are much closer to nature than the arcane, do not suffer such severe symptoms of withdrawal like many Sin'dorei.





- **Kael'thas** establishes a new militant regiment, known as the Sunfury, which he uses to begin purging the undead from Quel'Thalas.
 - Battlemage Daine Skyshroud eagerly enlists his aid in the Sunfury forces, and becomes one of the Prince's Spellbreakers.
 - Apprentice Flespir Everwyern, having remained in Quel'Thalas and been separated from his brother, is conscripted under the Sunfury forces and is put into service as a novice mounted spellcaster.
 - Sae'themar Sunfeather, being one of the Quel'dorei to have lived in Dalaran and served amongst the Kirin Tor, is conscripted into the Sunfury forces.
 - Vangellis Falwellow, Cael'braen Sunbreeze, Aelor Flameblade, and Baranthore Sunstriker enlist their support to Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, and join the Sunfury forces.
 - Colben Ornae does not join the Sunfury forces, but instead remains in Silvermoon to aid in reconstruction and defense against both the Scourge and potential Alliance incursions-believing them to be in some part responsible for the destruction of Quel'Thalas.
- Along with much of **Arthas'** forces, **Andinthe Sunstriker**, now a death knight under the thrall of the Scourge, arrives in Lordaeron and is dispatched to hunt down the living.
- Ethrian Duskrider works on behalf of the Quel'dorei forces under **Vereesa Windrunner**, hunting the Scourge throughout Lordaeron and gathering survivors where they can be found.
 - His experience as a mounted spellbow gives him a heavy advantage over the Scourge and enables him to stay in the air and off the ground. His work results in the location and rescue of countless groups of survivors who are recovered and brought to Dalaran, or other settlements throughout Lordaeron.


- Thrall establishes the New Horde on Kalimdor, rallying the tauren and trolls to become the first of its members.
- Sunfury forces under **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** begin to spread out across the ruins of Quel'Thalas and investigate their homes, towns, and holdouts, seeking out survivors.
 - Sae'themar Sunfeather is among the forces to return to their homes, and finds his
 family to have been raised by the Scourge. He battles against his siblings, and manages
 to save his mother who had been trapped within the family's estate.
 - O Driven to madness by grief and terror, Sae'themar's mother is driven into a fit of rage and attempts to self mutilate. Beyond helping, Sae'themar is forced to put her to rest. In honor of the fallen, he assumes a new surname, Bloodfeather.



- The Fall of Dalaran -

- **Arthas** and a reborn **Kel'thuzad** lead the Scourge onto Dalaran, seeking the <u>Book of Medivh</u> with which they intend to summon **Archimonde**, a demon lord of the Burning Legion.
 - The Scourge ravages the population of Dalaran, raising many into undeath.
 - Quin'el Dawnbringer and Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud both narrowly survive the destruction of Dalaran by joining others seeking refuge within the impregnable Violet Hold.
 - **Vereesa Windrunner** and those under her protection are safeguarded from the Scourge by many noble defenders, both elven and human alike. She and the magi, rangers, and soldiers under her command hold out and resist the Scourge's onslaught.
 - Arthas kills Archmage Antonidas, leader of the Kirin Tor in Dalaran, and Kel'thuzad summons Archimonde who promptly razes Dalaran to the ground.
- Llyreth Starseeker seeks to begin a new life in Stormwind, seeking work as a mercenary and bodyguard to those willing to hire.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough and other survivors arrive on Kalimdor and are welcomed by Alliance forces led by Jaina Proudmoore, daughter of Grand Admiral Daelin Proudmoore, leader of the kingdom of Kul Tiras.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough settles amongst the others who are the first denizens of Theramore Isle.






- Many paladins of the Scarlet Crusade defect, given the increasingly concerning rhetoric amongst the crusaders, and forge their own order, the Argent Dawn, believing that the Crusade had fallen from its path. They re-establish Light's Hope chapel as their base of operations.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker arrives at Dalaran too late to aid in its defense, or to reunite with her father, Magister Sallastus Boltseeker.
 - Believing him to have been slain by the Scourge, she continues south, seeking refuge amongst the dwarves of Ironforge.
- Archmage Idris Dawnstar, father of Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar, arrives in Southshore where he is reunited with his daughter and other surviving family members. The family stays in Southshore for a short while before traveling by ship to Stormwind City where they settle down.
- As the Sin'dorei continue clean up operations throughout Quel'Thalas, Zalvie Flameblade is assigned protection by the Sunfury forces, and a guardsman by the name of Tyran Sunbreak is assigned to her detail.


Year 21

- The Battle of Mount Hyjal -

- Thrall's Horde, and the reconstituted Alliance forces under Jaina Proudmoore, rally beside the Kaldorei of Kalimdor to battle the resurgent Burning Legion.
 - Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough contributes his mastery of darker magics against the demons of the Burning Legion, as well as the Scourge which are also present on Kalimdor. His aggressive hostility towards the newly discovered Horde survivors on the continent damages his relations with the Alliance forces under Jaina Proudmoore,



- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker arrives in Ironforge, and continues on her way to Stormwind City after a brief period of rest.
- The Kaldorei, led by **High Priestess Tyrande Whisperwind**, encounter the Alliance and Horde forces on Kalimdor and initially engage in hostilities before diplomatic ties are established.
 - Grommash Hellscream once again drinks the demon blood of Mannoroth the Destructor, believing it capable of providing the power needed to battle the Legion in Kalimdor. He is once again enslaved by the Burning Legion.
 - **Grommash Hellscream**'s Warsong Clan kills **Cenarius**, a Wild God of Kalimdor that is sacred to the Kaldorei.
 - This dramatic escalation leads the Horde and Alliance to hunt down **Grommash** and attempt to redeem him.
 - Successful in their efforts, **Grommash** is brought back under control.
 - o Thrall and Grommash hunt down and slay Mannoroth the Destructor.
- The Nathrezim Varimathras, Detheroc, and Balnazzar are dispatched by the Legion to Lordaeron where they are tasked with overseeing the Scourging of the continent.
- **High Priestess Tyrande Whisperwind** awakens the druids from their sleep within the barrow dens, including **Archdruid Malfurion Stormrage**.
 - While the High Priestess worked to rally the druids, Sentinel-Captain Shandris
 Feathermoon remained behind to command the defense of Mount Hyjal and the
 World Tree, Nordrassil.









- Illysanna Ravencrest, daughter of the hero Kur'talos Ravencrest, joins Lord **Illidan** and becomes one of his most loyal followers.
- During Lord Illidan's time away from Kalimdor, he discovers, confronts, and then recruits the aid of the gaga. Lady Vashj is dispatched as an emissary to lead the naga forces under Lord Illidan.
- In Stormwind, Apprentice Quellicia Dawnstar resumes her magical training and studies at the Arcane University.
- In recognition for her heroic leadership during the Third War, Sentinel-Captain Shandris **Feathermoon** is promoted to General of the Sentinels, and given commander over the entirety of their forces.
 - She establishes her command out of Feathermoon Stronghold, on Sardor Isle in Feralas.

- Appointment of the Regent Lord -

In Quel'Thalas, Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider appoints Lor'themar Theron, a Ranger Lord efforts to rebuild and safeguard the homeland.





- O Commander Zandayn Starbreeze is given a promotion to the rank of Captain, and given command of a squadron of repurposed merchant ships and salvaged elven destroyers, with *Dawning Sword* serving as her command ship. She is tasked with driving out raiders, opportunities, the Scourge, pirates, and anyone who would dare to provoke the Sin'dorei during such a dire time.
- Teremath Crimsonsun returns to Quel'Thalas after having escaped the Fall, and stayed away for some time. He aids in the reconstruction of Silvermoon, and begins to sort through the ruins of his family's destruction.
- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider reforges the shattered runeblade of the Sunstrider Dynasty, <u>Felo'melorn</u>, imbuing it with "magic, hatred, and a burning need for revenge."
- Spellbreaker Dame Skyshroud is elevated to the rank of Captain within the Sunfury forces under Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider.
- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider gathers his Sunfury forces and takes them south to support the Alliance against the undead in Lordaeron, and to gather aid from humanity to support Quel'Thalas in turn.
 - O Captain Daine Skyshourd, Vangellis Falwellow. Sae'themar Bloodfeather, and Willier Sylaine, the husband of Ary Wynters, are deployed with the Sunfury forces moving into Lordaeron. They support Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider's forces in combat.
 - O Hospir Everwyern accelerates his pyromancy training, embracing more and more wild methods in order to support the elven forces in Quel'Thalas. He is promoted to the rank of Arcanist, though he does not deploy with **Kael'thas'** forces and instead stays behind in Quel'Thalas to support the defense.

- High Priestess Tyrande Whisperwind and Archdruid Malfurion Stormrage arrive in Lordaeron while hunting Lord Illidan Stormrage. While Archdruid Malfurion works to understand the plague affecting the region, High Priestess Tyrande and Maiev Shadowsong venture further inland to begin tracking Lord Illidan. During their search they come across Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider and his forces.
 - O Together, the Sin'dorei and Kaldorei forces battle against the Scourge in order to escort an evacuation caravan. This rare show of cooperation between the divided elven races is the first notable point of contact between the two since the Exile of the Highborne some seven thousand years earlier.
 - Despite the collaboration between forces, High Priestess Tyrande is swept away by a
 river during an engagement. Maiev relays the news back to Archdruid Malfurion,
 and proclaims that High Priestess Tyrande had died in the battle, intending to focus
 Archdruid Malfurion's attention on hunting Lord Illidan.






- Grand Admiral Daelin Proudmoore journeys west from Kul Tiras in pursuit of his daughter, Lady Jaina Proudmoore, and those who fled Lordaeron with her.
 - Pursuing the Horde with full intentions of wiping out the remnant orcish population that fled Lordaeron, **Grand Admiral Proudmoore** launches an invasion of Durotar, using Theramore Isle as his base of operations.

Ary seeks out sorcerers and magi within the Kingdom from whom they can learn to

- Thrall's Horde murders Grand Admiral Proudmoore in Theramore with the aid of Lady Jaina Proudmoore, for which Jaina is declared persona non grata by the leadership and people of Kul Tiras.
- With the murder of **Grand Admiral Proudmoore**, the island nation of Kul Tiras cuts off ties with the Alliance after it refuses to pursue the Horde and to seek justice.
 - Lady Katherine Proudmoore assumes the mantle of Grand Admiral that was held by her husband in life.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough abandons Theramore and the Alliance following its failure to retaliate following the murder of **Grand Admiral Daelin Proudmoore**.
 - His disappointment in Theramore and Quel'Thalas' leadership leads him to depart and bury himself in study and practice once more.
 - He gathers as much research from the ruins of his sanctum in Quel'Thalas and avoids conflict on Azeroth in favor of furthering his mastery over magic.
- With the second defeat of the Burning Legion on Azeroth, many of the Legion's servants, now leaderless and directionless, begin to carve out their own domains and see to the corruption of Azeroth independent of any centralized leadership.





 During this time, she hunts down rogue demons and warlocks, and accepts other odd
 - During this time, she hunts down rogue demons and warlocks, and accepts other odd
 jobs and contracts that put her skills as a ranger to use.
- The Horde begins construction on Orgrimmar.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker, having arrived in Stormwind, begins to work with the remaining forces of the Alliance to counter the threat of the Scourge, and the Horde, amongst other threats.
 - In addition to addressing affairs on the Eastern Kingdoms, she also travels to Kalimdor to aid the Kaldorei in various affairs.
- The Sin'dorei in Quel'Thalas continue to try and rebuild, though they struggle dearly in holding back both the Scourge, and the Amani who take advantage of the weakened elven survivors.
 - Ellahora Emberlight focuses her attention on the duties of House Emberlight, and remains loyal to the Sin'dorei through their ongoing struggles over the next decade.
 - A Sin'dorei warrior named Lana'thel uncovers the High Elven blade <u>Quel'Delar</u> and takes it up as her own. She comes to serve under **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** himself.
- Quin'el Dawabringer and Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud remain in the ruins of Dalaran despite many calls to return home. Thinking themself too weak to face the destruction and death brought upon their homeland, they choose to stay in Dalaran.
 - For this, Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud is admonished by his uncle, Lord Mor'dischant
 Skyshroud, the patriarch of the Skyshroud house of Quel'Thalas.
- Magister Duskwither works to rebuild the Falthrien Academy on Sunstrider Isle and Duskwither Spire to use as bases of operations to conduct research and studies on a substitute for the Sunwell, intending to cure the Sin'dorei's magical addiction.
 - He dispatches his apprentices to begin exploring new avenues and conducting research to discover potential leads.



• In Lordaeron, **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider's** forces are outnumbered against the Scourge forces they are tasked with battling in Lordaeron, and he receives unexpected help from the naga-led by **Lady Vashj**.

capture Lord Illidan Stormrage, and imprison him.

- As punishment for allying his forces with the naga, Grand Marshal Othmar Garithos, leader of the Alliance forces in Lordaeron, sentences the Sin'dorei forces to death and has them imprisoned within the dungeons of Dalaran. Among those imprisoned is the spellbreaker Captain Dame Skyshroud.
- o Lady Vashj's forces stage a rescue of the Sin'dorei and stage a breakout.
- Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud, a magus of the Kirin Tor, hears of the Sin'dorei's imprisonment and secretly aids **Lady Vashj's** forces to liberate the prisoners–among which is his brother, Captain Dame Skyshroud.
- The elven and naga forces under **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and **Lady Vashj** escape from Dalaran and into the Outlands through interdimensional portals.
- Lady Vashj promises the Sin'dorei an opportunity to survive in the wake of the Sunwell's destruction.
- News of **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider's** denouncement and the imprisonment of the Sunfury forces fighting beside him, outrage explodes amongst the Sin'dorei in Quel'Thalas, and favor towards the Alliance suffers a steep drop.
 - Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud, a magus of the Kirin Tor who aided in the Sin'dorei's
 escape, sends word to his uncle, Lord Mordrethan Skyshroud-patriarch of the
 Skyshroud family— and his mother, Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud, and informs them
 of the survival and escape of Captain Daine Skyshroud.
 - Though this does not absolve the Archmage of his alleged betrayal of the Skyshroud family by not having returned to Quel'Thalas after the fall, it does prompt a sign of



- O Despite prior good relations with the Alliance personnel at the camp, Zalvie Flameblade and her guardsmen, including Captain Tyran Sunbreak, are ambushed by human soldiers.
- While most of her guardsmen are killed, both Zalva Plandblade and Captain Sunbreak survive, thanks only to the emergence and awakening of the hereditary ward of protection bound to Zalvies bloodline.
- The activation of this ward summons forth a phoenix which empowers **Zalvie** in battle, and enables her to drive back and eliminate the attackers.
- Once safe, Zalvie Flameblade, Captain Sunbreak, and the few surviving guardsmen report back to Quel'Thalas to inform the Magistry of the incident.
- Zalvie Flameblade and her retinue spend several months recovering in Silvermoon City.
- Discovering the capture and imprisonment of **Lord Illidan Stormrage** by the warden **Maiev Shadowsong** in the Outlands, **Lady Vashj** and **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** join forces and launch an assault on the Kaldorei forces, and manage to liberate **Lord Illidan**.
 - This conflict brings Highborne descendent sorcerers, the Sin'dorei, and Kaldorei forces into direct conflict with each other in a way not seen since the War of the Ancients.
- Lady Vashj introduces the Sin'dorei to Lord Illidan Stormrage, who assures the elves of the power he can offer, referring to the Fel.
 - **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** swears the Sin'dorei's loyalty to **Lord Illidan**, and leads his people in the consumption of the Fel as a substitute for the arcane.
 - Already having a considerable history of consuming fel energy, Cael'braen Sunbreeze eagerly embraces this new path for the Sin'dorei and openly begins to practice his dark sorcery as a warlock in service to **Prince Kael'thas**.
 - Vangellis Falwellow is one of the many Sin'dorei who partake in the acceptance of Fel magic as a substitute for the Sunwell's energy.




- Attempts to communicate with the Sin'dorei do not develop into positive results.
- **Sylvanas Windrunner** and her dark rangers venture north to Deatholme and recover her corpse, which she inhabits once more.
- Spellbreaker Captain Daine Skyshroud arranges a meeting with his cousin, Magistrix Taileth Skyshroud, who had survived the destruction of Draenor and resided at the Allerian Stronghold.
 - Learning the fate of her family and her kingdom back on Azeroth, Magistic Taileth is
 distraught, and nearly swayed by her cousin to join the Sunfury forces. Her knowledge
 of fel magic and its corrupting influence, however, leads her to refuse.
 - The disagreement sparks tensions between the cousins, and is fueled by resentment towards the Magistrix for not having been present to safeguard Quel'Thalas from the Scourge, and an unwillingness to rejoin her family.
 - The cousins part ways on bitter terms, and it becomes the last time they ever see each other.
- Sylvanas Windrunner is invited to meet with the Nathrezim in Lordaeron and agrees to a pact with them to betray and defeat **Arthas**, who had taken control of the Scourge and turned against the Legion.
- The demon lord **Kil'jaeden** commands **Lord Illidan Stormrage** and his forces to return to Azeroth and destroy the **Lich King**.
- **Sylvanas Windrunner** and her Darkfallen lead a revolt against Arthas in Lordaeron, and break the **Lich King's** control over many of the scourge in Lordaeron.
 - Dark Ranger Braeden Starbreeze is among those who aid Sylvanas in the Darkfallen Revolt.
 - O Sylvanas creates a new faction called the Forsaken, and titles herself the Banshee Queen. The Dark Rangers become her most trusted operatives.



- Sunfury forces under the command of Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider journey north to
 Icecrown in service to Lord Illidan Stormrage, drawing many soldiers from Quel'Thalas and
 leaving it further weakened against attacks by the Scourge. They are accompanied by Lady
 Vashj and her naga.
 - Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Captain Zandayn Starbreeze are among the ship captains tasked with ferrying the Sunfury forces to Icecrown, which they do aboard Silverspell and Dawning Sword.
 - O Colben Ornae, Baranthore Sunstriker, Cael'braen Sunbreeze, spellbreaker Caprain Dame Skyshroud, and Vangellis Falwellow join the Sunfury contingent traveling to Northrend, but Colben is dispatched back to Silvermoon partway through the campaign to reinforce Silvermoon's garrison against continued Scourge attacks.
 - Lord Illidan, Prince Kael'thas, and Lady Vashj's forces battle against Prince
 Arthas and his Scourge in Northrend in an effort to stop the death knight from his
 efforts to merge with the Lich King.
 - O Lana'thel, wielder of Quel'Delar, joins the mission north, but is slain by Arthas Menethil—cut down by his runeblade, Frostmourne. She is raised into undeath as Blood-Queen Lana'thel, leader of the San'layn, a sect of vampiric elves.
 - o Prince Kael'thas engages Arthas in battle.

It must be noted here that elven runeblades, unlike typical weapons, grow stronger each time they are broken and reforged. Due to the nature of these blades, <u>Felo'melorn</u> did not shatter against <u>Frostmourne</u> when **Prince Kael'thas** battled the death knight, unlike during **King Anasterian's** battle against **Arthas**.



The Death Knight Arthas Menethil battling Lord Illidan Stormrage.


- Arthas Menethil defeats Lord Illidan and merges with the Lich King.
 - O Defeated, Lord Illidan, Prince Kael'thas, and Lady Vashj return to the Outlands.
 - o **Prince Kael'thas'** blade, <u>Felo'melorn</u>, is left behind in Northrend, though the circumstances of this occurrence are not currently known.
 - Arcania Hespir Everwyern finally journeys to the Outlands to join the Sunfury forces and is made to embrace fel energies as a substitute for the arcane. He has a difficult time acclimating, which leads to several traumatic experiences that affect his social and emotional state.
 - Vangellis Falwellow is tasked with healing and counseling Arcania: Hespir Everwyorn, among many other Sin'dorei who had suffered during the fighting in Northrend.
 - After the defeat in Northrend, Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Captain Zandayn Starbreeze return to Quel'Thalas to aid in the continued reconstruction efforts.




- Queen, **Sylvanas Windrunner**, seeks out the aid of the Horde.
 - She works to establish ties with the tauren, which leads to the formal induction of the Forsaken into the Horde.
- Distraught by her plight, and unable to look at her blade any longer, the San'layn Blood-Queen Lana'thel destroys Quel'Delar and scatters the pieces.
- The **Archdruid Malfurion Stormrage** returns to the Emerald Dream to slumber, leaving Fandral Staghelm to lead the druids in his absence. High Priestess Tyrande Whisperwind continues to lead the Kaldorei at large.


- Lord Illidan Stormrage and the Sin'dorei and naga, led by Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider and Lady Vashj, respectively, arrive in the Outlands and begin to fortify the ruins of the world for their own purposes.
 - **Lord Illidan Stormrage** begins training the first generation of Demon Hunters.
 - grows wary of Lord Illidan Stormrage and Prince Kael'thas' pact with the demon hunter - uncomfortable with their draw towards the Fel.
 - The Sin'dorei struggle to adapt in the wastes of the Outlands, still suffering from fatigue and withdrawal after the destruction of the Sunwell. The consumption of fel energy, while suitable in the short term, only worsens the Sin'dorei's magical addiction, leaving them vulnerable without a steady supply.
 - Conflict between the Sunfury forces under Prince Kael'thas, and Quel'dorei expeditionary forces under Ranger-Captain Auric Sunchaser occurs on a more frequent basis, and tensions continue to sour.
 - Magister Feature Queldorah's opinions of the Sin'dorei solidify as hostilities intensify and the consumption and use of fel magic by their magisters draws them into closer




- consuming fel energy as a substitute for mana crystals.
 The former Highborne sorcerer turned satyr, Lord Vyletongue, ventures into the vast caverns of western Kalimdor known as Maraudon and spreads corruption throughout the caves.
 - He works to summon other demons and corrupt the wildlife within the caverns.
- Seeking to renew the Kaldorei's immortality, **Fandral Staghelm** convinces the Ancients of Darkshore to aid in the growth of a new World Tree, which is planted and empowered off the northwestern coast of Kalimdor.
 - The druids call this new tree Teldrassil, meaning *Crown of the Earth* in the ancient even tongue, and it becomes a new home for the Kaldorei.
 - The elves congregate there and build a new city, Darnassus, amongst its boughs.
- **Arthas**, now ruling the Scourge as **Lich King**, begins to raise the dead left behind in the numerous battles fought since the rise of the Scourge.
 - The **Lich Kel'Thuzad** assumes command of the remaining forces of the Scourge in eastern Lordaeron.
 - The **Lich Amnennar the Coldbringer** assumes command of the remaining forces of the Scourge in southern Kalimdor.
 - The Scourge begins construction on the necropolis Acherus: the Ebon Hold, which is intended to become the headquarters of the Death Knights of Acherus.
- Within the boughs of Teldrassil, the newest World Tree, the Kaldorei druids work to nurture and grow the mighty tree.
 - Within one of its many secluded vales, the druids work to shape and grow Aldrassil, one of the many great trees of Kalimdor, and stone and wood masons work to construct a lodge at the base of the tree, weaving it into the very heart of the tree.




- Sabariel Elizabeth Greenwood Dawnbreaker is confronted by her brother, Magister Arthanal Alexander Dawnbreaker, when passing the Thandol Span.
 - The two come to blows and fight, nearly to the death, with the bitter resentment and sense of betrayal from during the Fall of Quel'Thalas proving to be an overbearing weight.
 - The confrontation prompts Sabariel to forsake the name Dawnbreaker, and she adopts the surname Greenwood instead.
- Within the tree covered vale of Shadowglen, nestled deep in the boughs of Teldrassil, many Kaldorei migrate and come to settle within the lodge constructed at the base of the great tree Aldrassil.
 - O Among those who settle are the merchants and settlers Conservator Ilthalaine, Dellylah, Dirania Silvershine, Freja Nightwing, Gilshalan Windwalker, Janna Brightmoon, Keina, Khardan Proudblade, Lyrai, and Orenthil Whisperwind; the warrior Alyissia; the pathstalkers Ayanna Everstride and Frahun Shadewhisper; the druids Mardant Strongoak, Melithar Staghelm, and Tenaron Stormgrip; the priestess Shanda; and a garrison of Sentinels.
- Grand Magister Rommath is dispatched by Prince Kael'thas to return home from the Outlands and spread the teachings of Lord Illidan Stormrage to the Sin'dorei.
 - O Zalvie Flameblade and her retinue also return to Silvermoon.
 - Grand Magister Rommath and many of his magisters, including Zalvie Hameblade, spread knowledge of Felmancy and guide the Sin'dorei in consuming Fel energy as a substitute for the arcane, bolstering their efforts against the Scourge with new, powerful magics.
 - Colben Ornae remains in Silvermoon, despite his reservations about the Sin'dorei's recent change in direction.



- o In the midst of her work, she is drawn to the Shrine of Mel'Thandris after learning of the war in a book, and discovers the <u>Scythe of Elune</u> hidden within the Shrine's grove.
- Finding herself able to communicate with the worgen through the <u>Scythe of Elune</u>,
 Velinde summons the feral wolf-men to Azeroth once more and leads them into battle against the demons of Felwood.
- With the feral worgen at her side, **Velinde** makes considerable progress in hunting down and annihilating the remaining demons, only to realize that the <u>Scythe of Elune</u> had begun to slip beyond her control, and was enabling the arrival of more and more worgen on its own.
- O Danebb Skyshroud and the other druids of his pack, who were sealed away at a shrine to Elune in the wilds of Feralas, are awakened by the Scythe of Elune. Trapped within the grove, they linger within the grove, granted calm and balance, but still bound to their pack form.
- Seeking information and a way to regain control over the <u>Scythe of Elune</u>, **Velinde Starsong** learns of **Archmage Arugal**, formerly of Dalaran infamy, who had returned to his homeland of Gilneas and settled at Pyrewood Keep along the western coast, only to later be tasked by the **King Genn Greymane** of Gilneas with summoning the worgen to aid the beleaguered humans against the Scourge.



- subsequently found its way into the hands of the wolf cult, and then the Kaldorei Valorn Stillbough.
- **Valorn Stillbough** delivers the <u>Scythe of Elune to the</u> safety of Tal'doren, a great tree tied to the Emerald Dream, located in the secluded kingdom of Gilneas.
- Dorian Fallowmarsh rebuilds his family's adventuring and archaeological studies business in Silvermoon, drawing upon the wealth of opportunities with the Sin'dorei presence in the Outlands.
 - Though only twenty two years old, Dorian begins to hire adventurers, sorcerers, archaeologists, and thieves to begin recovering artifacts from the Outlands, and from across the ruins of Quel'Thalas.
 - He is keen to include his three younger siblings in the family business, and strives to teach them all the lessons he learned from his parents when they were still alive.
- Darkness begins to fester across Teldrassil, the World Tree, largely in the form of Fel Moss.
 - The grellkin succumb to this corruption of the Emerald Nightmare, which had taken root within the boughs of the tree, and begin to spread it across Teldrassil.
 - The further spread of corruption drives the local furbolgs from their homes, and they begin to amass in greater numbers under a new name–the Gnarlpine.
 - Doth the grellkin and furbolgs begin to threaten the peace and balance of the new tree.
- Not all Sin'dorei prove to be keen on embracing the teachings of **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and **Lord Illidan Stormrage**, and fearing the discord and infighting that would result of trying to lead a divided nation, **Regent Lord Lor'themar Theron** exiles from Quel'Thalas all those who refuse to embrace the nation's new direction.
- Ranger Lord Renthar Hawkspear is among the many elves who are exiled from Quel'Thalas.



- The siblings establish their work, which would continue for several years, operating first out of primitive camps established in the open and later in nearby caves. Their use and knowledge of blood magic is expanded upon through their continuing research.
- Vereesa Windrunner begins to gather the surviving Quel'dorei spread throughout Lordaeron, including those who had fled south from Quel'Thalas, and works to bring order to the disparate people.
 - The surviving Alliance forces make peace with the Quel'dorei, and seek to make amends for the actions of **Grand Marshal Garithos** who attempted to wipe out the remaining elves under **Prince Kael'thas'** command.
 - Vereesa Windrunner leads many of the surviving Quel'dorei in establishing an enclave in the ruins of Dalaran. It becomes a sanctuary for all those of elven blood who fled Quel'Thalas during the Fall.
 - Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud is among the early members of this cohort of elves, and he cements himself as pillar for many of the distraught refugees to lean on.
 - Llyreth Starseeker hears word of the enclave's formation and journeys to Dalaran where he pledges himself to the **Vereesa Windrunner**. He is tasked with leading a small cadre of battle-mages.
- The dryad **Tarindrella**, an ancient woodland protector of Kalimdor, makes her first appearance in many long years.
 - The dryad travels to the blossoming World Tree, Teldrassil, a place she senses a strange darkness growing, and comes to reside within the Shadowglen vale.
- Watchers Morta and Fero depart Quel'Thalas with the intent of chronicling the histories and stories of adventurers acting on behalf of the Horde and Alliance across Azeroth.

Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud continues to serve as a magi of the Kirin Tor, aiding in reconstruction efforts, and heading new research projects to improve the nation's defenses. He is instrumental in welcoming refugees who are seeking safety in the wake of mass purges in Quel'Thalas. Bearing the Skyshroud name, he is a familiar name to many of the exiled Quel'dorei who subsequently settle in Dalaran.

- A New World -

- The Alliance of Lordaeron, having been brought to ruin, is no more. In its place, a new Grand Alliance is forged under the leadership of the Kingdom of Stormwind.
 - The Gnomes are nearly driven to extinction after a coup leaves the city, and most of its population, irradiated. They are granted refuge in Ironforge.
 - The Kaldorei formally join the Alliance, alongside the Dwarves and Gnomes.
 - O Surviving Quel'dorei are also counted amongst the population of the Alliance, though without any formal leadership. They live as refugees within Stormwind, Theramore, and several other outlying townships.
- After particularly heavy rainfalls during the spring across the boughs of Teldrassil, the World Tree planted by, and now home to the Kaldorei, some of the native wildlife flourishes excessively, disrupting the cycle of balance.
 - **Conservator Ilthalaine** works to manage the delicate balance within the Shadowglen vale, and dispatches aids to thin the rapidly expanding populations of boars and sabers.



Through the work of these Kaldorei, it is confirmed that Fel Moss has begun to spread across Teldrassil.


- In Quel'Thalas, Grand Magister Rommath employs his magisters to effect a brutal crackdown on dissidents speaking out against the use of Fel magic, spurring on tensions within the struggling nation and leading many to flee Quel'Thalas and seek out the surviving Quel'dorei in Stormwind, Theramore, the Hinterlands, Dalaran, and other territories.
 - Others, heeding Grand Magister Rommath's call to join into the service of Lord **Illidan Stormrage**, journey to the Outlands and join the Sunfury forces and the many subdivisions of Prince Kael'thas' army.
 - remains in Silvermoon and helps to train new soldiers for the Sin'dorei military.
- Prince Kael'thas' forces expand their holdings in the Outlands, and also begin pursuing new research and magic to wield against their enemies. The Sin'dorei forces in the Outlands are divided into numerous subdivisions, including the Sunfury, Sunhawks, Eclipsion, Firewing, and also the Sin'dorei training under **Lord Illidan Stormrage**, called the Illidari.
 - The Sin'dorei also begin research and development on a mana-bomb, much of which is conducted in Terokkar Forest.






A Sin'dorei Spellbreaker battles a Draenei arcanist in the Outlands.


- The Firewing forces led by **Sharth Voldoun** establish footholds in Terokkar Forest.
 - The Firewing quickly begin work expanding on the research and development of mana bombs.
- In service to the Kirin Tor, Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud begins to coordinate efforts to gather information from inside Quel'Thalas concerning **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and his followers after hearing word of the Sin'dorei's recent ventures.
 - O Startled to learn of the wayward **Prince's** ability to venture to the ruined world of Draenor, now known as the Outlands, he believes there might be an opportunity to reconnect with his cousin, **Magistrix Taileth Skyshroud**, who vanished with the Alliance Expedition some two decades prior.
 - He begins to reach out to contacts within Quel'Thalas, though finds many former colleagues reluctant to converse with him given the Alliance and Kirin Tor's persecution of the Sin'dorei.
- The Sunfury and Sunhawk forces, under the command of **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and his lieutenants, **Pathaleon the Calculator**, **Master Daellis Dawnstrike**, the demon **Sironas**, and **Matis the Cruel**, carve a path through the Netherstorm and secure much of the territory.
 - With control established, the Sunfury erect Mana Forges, designed to draw upon the latent energy bound to the atmosphere in that region.



- Aveanist Hespit Everwyern journeys with the Sunfury forces to the Netherstorm where he continues to expand his mastery of pyromancy, while also consuming the Fel as a substitute for the arcane.
 - He is deployed on numerous sorties in the region with other dragonhawk riders; he becomes a highly gifted, albeit young, mounted sorcerer amongst the Sunfury forces.
- Master Daellis Dawnstrike leads a detachment of Sunfury forces against Kirin'Var Village, a holdout of magi forces from the Alliance Expedition.
 - Spellbinder Maryana, Spellreaver Marathelle, spellbreaker Capitain Daine
 Skyshroud, and Summoner Kanthin are present and support the Sunfury forces during the strike.
 - The Sunfury forces deploy and detonate a mana bomb within the village, entirely wiping out the populace, save for a small handful of mages, including **Archmage Vargoth** of the Kirin Tor.
 - **Conjurer Luminrath**, one of the elven magi who was stationed at Kirin'Var with the Alliance forces, is one of many elves killed by **Daellis Dawnstrike's** forces.
- Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud hears word of the Sin'dorei's development and use of a mana bomb through contacts in Quel'Thalas who are close to the Sunfury forces, and resolves to return to Quel'Thalas himself to find more information.
 - The Archmage gathers a small company of mage blades and spell shields who teleport into a ruined sanctum in the south of Quel'Thalas.
 - Upon arrival in the ruined sanctum, the Quel'dorei are faced with an onslaught of undead magi, all of whom were slain and raised by the Scourge during the Fall of Quel'Thalas.
 - A battle breaks out within the ruins and the intense power unleashed by the Quel'dorei mages alerts Sin'dorei ley guardians who promptly respond. Farstriders and Sin'dorei



- Further, numerous subdivisions of the Sunfury are established, including the Sunseekers, the Crimson Hand, the Bloodwarders–under the leadership of **Commander Sarannis**–and later the Dawnblade, Shadowsword, and Sunblade divisions.
 - Spellbreaker Captain Daine Skyshroud is transferred into the Crimson Hand division of the Sunfury army, and tasked with leading a large cohort of spellbreakers.
- The Eclipsion forces, under the command of **Grand Commander Ruusk**, strike deep into Shadowmoon Valley, establishing strongholds intended to support and defend **Lord Illidan Stormrage's** main base of operations: the Black Temple.
 - Chancellor Bloodleaf, a high ranking member of Lord Illidan's Illidari forces, is tasked with leading the Eclipsion's efforts to recruit or compel the nearby giants to join Lord Illidan's forces.
- The Illidari forces under the command of the Illidari Council, composed of the priestess Lady
 Malande, the Blood Knight Gathios the Shatterer, the rogue Veras Darkshadow, and
 High Nethermancer Zerevor, establish their headquarters in the Black Temple, and direct
 operations throughout Shadowmoon Valley.
 - Some of the strongest Sin'dorei magi and warriors are tasked with joining the Illidari, the force of demon hunters personally trained by **Lord Illidan Stormrage**.
- Arcania Hespii Everwyern is dispatched with a small company under the command of Ranger-Captain Thenferos Sunsire, and tasked with breaking a heavily fortified outpost in the region in what becomes known as the Battle for Fluxspire Ridge.
 - Arcanist Hespir joins two other mounted spellcasters and supports **Ranger-Captain Sunsire's** forces in their assault. Arcanist Hespir is pitted against an expeditionary force of the Sons of Lothar which puts up fierce resistance.
 - The battle lasts the better part of a day as the Sunfury forces struggle to overcome the entrenched defenders.



- The Trials of Azeroth's Defenders -

- Sabariel Elizabeth Greenwood Greenwood continues work as a mercenary within the Alliance territories, and builds a reputation as a fierce hunter of demons and other monsters.
- A mercenary company known as the Veiled Blade undertakes a contract to assassinate the drakonid general **Lord Valthalak** in the upper reaches of the upper spire of Blackrock Mountain, and then to steal a spellbook in his possession.
 - Despite succeeding in their task, a schism erupts over possession of a powerful necklace worn by the general. The conflict, allegedly complicated by the arrival of General Valthalak's ghost, leaves several members of the company dead and the rest fleeing for their lives with pieces of the now-shattered necklace. The legitimacy of this claim cannot be verified, it should be noted.
 - The Kaldorei priestess, **Isalien**, one of the company's members, claims ownership of the left piece of the necklace and departs the company for good.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker continues her work for the Alliance across Azeroth, traveling between the Eastern Kingdoms and Kalimdor, aiding both the kingdoms of Stormwind and Ironforge, and the Kaldorei of Darnassus.
- Magister Duskwither's efforts and research to discover a cure for the Sin'dorei's magical addiction prompts him to experiment with drawing out arcane magic from the Fel, potentially offering a way to cure their addiction and counter the effects of fel magic.
 - His experiments fail, however, and his apprentice, **Telethayon**, dies as a result of the experiment.
 - Collected research notes later reveal that several more apprentices are tragically killed during subsequent experimentation.
 - Seeking to halt any further tragedies, Magister Duskwither sends his apprentices away and retreats from Duskwither Spire, where many of the experiments had been



- The Horde cements itself as chief rival to the Alliance, drawing strength from the trolls, orcs, tauren, and Forsaken.
- Magus **Braelyn Firehand**, a servant of the Legion's Shadow Council, operating out of Jaedenar, on Kalimdor, is dispatched to the Stonetalon Mountains to eradicate the Kaldorei presence at the summit in order to restore the flow of magic to the region.
 - This assertion, that the Kaldorei at this time maintained active efforts to stifle or mute arcane energy, is one of several claims of which the legitimacy cannot be verified at this time.
 - **Braelyn Firehand** dispatches agents of the Horde to eliminate the Kaldorei's presence at the summit of the mountain.
 - She also dispatches agents of the Horde to eliminate **Keeper Ordanus**, one of the eldest sons of the Wild God **Cenarius**, in Ashenvale.
 - Keeper Ordanus is slain in the halls of the Raynewood Retreat in Ashelvane Forest.
- The Lich King continues to expand his ranks, and begins to recruit the Vrykul into the Scourge, stretching his control across Northrend.
 - The Lich King and his Cult of the Damned continue to raise powerful, fallen heroes as Death Knights.
 - The San'layn under Blood Queen Lana'thel also continue to expand their ranks and influence.
- The Alliance leads an assault on Blackrock Mountain, with minimal help from Stormwind itself due to the interference of Lady Katrina Prestor, advisor to Regent Lord Bolvar Fordragon.
 - o It should be noted that, unbeknownst to the Regency of Stormwind and the nobility at the time, Lady Katrina Prestor was, in truth, the obsidian dragon Onyxia, daughter of Deathwing. She had been utilizing her position to sow discord and impede Alliance efforts to rebuild.

• The Horde leads an assault on upper Blackrock Spire, slaying **Nefarian**, the son of Deathwing.

- Regent Lord Lor'themar Theron, ruling Silvermoon in place of Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, guides the Sin'dorei in rebuilding their ruined homeland, Quel'Thalas.
 - With support from Banshee Queen Sylvanas Windrunner and her Forsaken, the Sin'dorei begin courting the idea of joining into the Horde.
 - O Vangellis Falwellow hears word of the Sin'dorei's intention to join the Horde and grows concerned over this new development. Having fought in the Second War, allying with the orcs is unthinkable to him.
- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider provides information regarding the presence of uncorrupted orcs within the Outlands, which is then used as leverage in negotiations with the Horde.




- An army division under the command of
 Captain Aeldon Sunbrand, known as the Blood Hawks, launches a large-scale operation to secure Falconwing Square in the western, ruined half of Silvermoon City.
 - Fierce fighting ensues, and many Sin'dorei are drawn in to support the effort.
 - After a rapid assault and the arrival of reinforcements, Captain Aeldon Sunbrand's forces take control of Falconwing Square and coordinate efforts to fortify and repair it.
 - Using it as a base of operations, they prepare to launch a new offensive into the ruined portion of the city to secure it for the Sin'dorei so that further reconstruction there can commence.
- **Prince Tortheldrin** and his undead Shen'dralar in the ruined city Eldre'Thalas, located in present day Feralas, begin to stir as explorers from both the Horde and Alliance venture into the dense jungle.
 - The Horde dispatches a raiding party to pillage the ruins, and lay waste to the remaining elves. The Highborne who narrowly escape the slaughter flee into the wilderness, only to begrudgingly seek out the Kaldorei for support some years later.




- Horde agents, operating in the eastern, plague riddled lands of Lordaeron, dispatch forces to assault and sack the Quel'Lithien lodge on the border between Lordaeron and Quel'Thalas.
 - The Quel'dorei rangers and magi manning the lodge, under the command of **Ranger-Lord Renthal Hawkspear**, struggle to repulse the raiding party, and suffer numerous casualties. Despite the losses, the Quel'dorei are able to drive back the raiders and hold the Lodge.
- Deep within the ruins of Eldre'Thalas, an adventurer uncovers a tome which is returned to **Lorekeeper Lydros** in the Athenaeum of the ruined city.
 - Lorekeeper Lydros reveals the importance of the text, noting that since the protective seal upon the tome was broken, anyone who took possession of the text could have learned and exploited its secret contents: knowledge of weapon forging and dragon slaying.
 - The Shen'dralar lorekeeper presents the dull, poorly aged blade <u>Quel'Serrar</u>, one of the many prismatic blades forged by Kaldorei and dragon smiths more than ten thousand years prior.
 - Lydros is reported to have explained that the blade was forged in the fire breath of several dragons who consented to heat and mold the metals and imbue it with their blood and magic.
 - The adventurer is tasked with reforging the blade in the flames of a dragon's breath, and is sent away from Eldre'Thalas until they are able to complete their task.
- Magus **Braelyn Firehand**, a member of the Shadow Council working in secret within the Horde, withdraws from the Stonetalon Mountains to serve the Legion elsewhere on Azeroth.



- One of **Magister Duskwither's** apprentices, **Apprentice Feledren**, is dispatched to Falthrien Academy, though he fails to heed the warnings of his instructors and succumbs to his magical addiction, leading him to become one of the Wretched.
 - Unstable and driven to madness, his reckless use of arcane magic leads to the arcane anomalies that drive the rest of the students from the Academy.
- Banshee Queen Sylvanas Windrunner and her Forsaken, along with elements of the Scourge and Alliance adventurers, drive the Scarlet Crusade in Lordaeron to the brink of extinction.
 - Many of the survivors flee to Northrend and Eastern Lordaeron.
- **King Varian Wrynn** returns to Stormwind from his captivity and reveals the true identity of **Katrina Preston**, an advisor to **Regent Lord Bolvar Fordragon**, as **Onyxia** the obsidian dragon and daughter of **Deathwing**.
 - o King Varian resumes his place as rightful King of Stormwind.
 - The human king then leads a war party to do battle with Onyxia in her lair in the swamps of Dustwallow Marsh.
 - The wielder of the poorly aged prismatic blade, <u>Quel'Serrar</u>, joins **King Varian's** war party and is present for the battle against **Onyxia**. In the heat of the dragon's breath, the weapon is reforged.
 - King Varian and his forces slay Onyxia.
 - **Quel'Serrar** is plunged into the obsidian dragon's body, enabling it to absorb the blood and essence of the dragon.
 - **King Varian** and his party return to Stormwind with the obsidian dragon's head, which is mounted beneath the gates of the city.
 - Regent Lord Bolvar Fordragon steps down as Regent and assumes the position of Highlord. He serves as King Varian Wrynn's right hand.



- reconstruction efforts enable the return of civilian and support personnel.
 - Additional Silvermoon Guardians arrive to reinforce the defenses of Falconwing Square, enabling the Bloodhawks to prepare further advances into the ruined portions of the city.
 - An inn is reopened, under the administration of Innkeeper Delaniel, which serves as a local hub and point of refuge for survivors.
- The wielder of Quel'Serrar, having successfully reforged the ancient high elven prismatic blade in the flame breath of **Onyxia**, daughter of the former Black Dragonflight Aspect **Deathwing**, returns to Eldre'Thalas with the blade and meets with **Lorekeeper Lydros** in the Athenaeum.
 - The restored blade is approved by the **Lorekeeper**, and is entrusted to the adventurer. Accounts of the whereabouts of the blade are, from this point forward, unheard of.
- The Qiraji are awakened by the call of the Old God, C'thun, and swarm beyond the walls of Ahn'qiraj in southern Kalimdor. The resurgence of the Qiraji leads to a joint response from the Horde and the Alliance.
 - o High Overlord Saurfang leads the Might of Kalimdor, the Alliance and Horde's finest soldiers, in defeating the Qiraji and slaying C'thun.
- Highlord Bolvar Fordragon recruits heroes to lead an assault on the Scourge's citadel of Naxxramas in the Eastern Plaguelands with support from the Horde and the Argent Dawn.
- Lord Illidan Stormrage's forces, and the Orcish Horde in the Outlands, chase the native Draenei to the brink of extinction and continue to bring upheaval to the ruined world.
 - Archmage Khadgar, leader of the Alliance Expedition in the Outlands, calls out to the Naaru, summoning them to the Outlands after sensing greater dangers approaching.
 - The Burning Legion invades the Outlands in an effort to dethrone Lord Illidan Stormrage.



• **Prince Kael'thas'** Sunfury forces, having witnessed the arrival of the Tempest Keep, coordinate and plan an assault on the fortress.

• Gathering a large host in the Netherstorm, **Prince Kael'thas** launches a brutal and surprising assault against the Tempest Keep installation.

- The Sunfury and Crimson Hand forces, under the direct command of **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** himself, assault the central structure known as The Eye, while the Bloodwarders–under the leadership of **Commander Sarannis**–assault one of the satellite vessels, the Botanica. **Pathaleon the Calculator** launches yet a third, separate strike, leading the Sunseekers in capturing the Mechanar and then assisting with the Bloodwarders' assault on the Botanica.
- Captain Daine Skyshroud is a part of the Crimson Hand forces who assault and capture The Eye.
- The Naaru flee the installations during the multi-pronged assault save for one, **M'uru**, who is captured.
 - Prince Kael'thas returns the captured Naaru, M'uru, to Silvermoon City for the Sin'dorei to use as a source of energy. Vangellis Falwellow is part of the delegation that returns to Silvermoon with the captured Naaru.
- Grand Magister Rommath and Magister Astalor Bloodsworn conceive the idea to empower Sin'dorei priests with power from the captured Naaru. They task Lady Liadrin to lead this new militant force of Light wielders, an answer to the many paladins in service to the Alliance.
 - O Colben Ornae, Baranthore Sunstriker, and Vangellis Falwellow join the other priests and Sin'dorei paladins under **Lady Liadrin** and her second in command, **Lord**

Solanar Bloodwrath, in siphoning mana and holy power from the captured Naaru, M'uru, in Silvermoon City.

O Under leadership of Matriarch Lady Liadrin, the order of the Blood Knights is founded, Sin'dorei paladins who siphon the holy Light rather than wield it through faith.

Seeking an escape from the crumbling Outlands, host now to the Legion and Lord Illidan Stormrage's armies, the Draenei–led by the Prophet Velen–stage an attack on the Tempest Keep and steal away from the Outlands aboard the Exodar, one of the satellite vessels of the fortress.

- The Sin'dorei Sunhawk forces aboard sabotage the ship while in transit.
- The Exodar crash lands on Azeroth's Silvergale Isles, which are heavily affected by an energy crystals knocked loose from the wrecked ship.
- One of the islands in particular becomes so thoroughly corrupted that it takes on a blood red hue, and is thereafter known to the Kaldorei and the Draenei as Bloodmyst Isle.
- The Sunhawks who managed to survive the crash of the Exodar begin an intense campaign to open and connect a Sungate from Bloodmyst Isle to the Outlands in order to summon reinforcements and eliminate the Draenei.
 - Sin'dorei reinforcements are summoned from the Outlands to reinforce the Sunhawk's position, and several notable commanders and lieutenants relocate to the Isle to ensure the success of the mission.
- Cael'braen Sunbreeze concludes his hunt for demons within Silvermoon City and turns his focus to aiding the other magisters and sorcerers in rebuilding and retraining the elven armies.
- The Sons of Lothar struggle to survive in the Outlands as they are now opposed by **Lord Illidan Stormrage**, the Burning Legion, *and* the remnants of the Horde lingering in the Outlands.






- The Kaldorei investigate the Exodar's crash and work to provide relief and support to the survivors.
 - The elven Sunhawk divisions on Bloodmyst Isle are defeated, and their leaders executed.
 - This in turn leads to the Draenei formally agreeing to join the Alliance.

- The Rebirth of Quel'Thalas -

- Under Regent Lord Lor'themar's direction, Halduron Brightwing, Grand Magister Rommath, Lady Liadrin, and the organized military command of the Regent Lord's regime launches a major initiative and counter-offensive to reclaim much of Quel'Thalas from the Scourge and other opportunists and threats.
- Ley-Keeper Velania is dispatched from Silvermoon to oversee the West Arcane Sanctum in northern Eversong.
 - O Her investigation into the Sanctum reveals that recent efforts to increase the power loads on the sanctums has resulted in the emergence of arcane anomalies and wraiths, which pose a serious threat to the stability of ley-lines in the region, and therefore could potentially cut off Silvermoon from a steady flow of energy.
- A coalition of magisters under **Well Watcher Solanian** spearhead an operation to drive out remnant Scourge and withering elves from Sunstrider Isle, an effort which draws in a large number of highly skilled Sin'dorei, including:
 - O Arcanists Helion, Ithanas, Julia Sunstriker, Lanthan Perilon, Lord Mordinalan Shyshroud, and Magister Erona; the warlock Yasmine Teli'Larien and her partner, Summoner Teli'Larien; the Blood Knight Jesthenis Sunstriker; the priestess Matron Arena; Delios Silverblade; the Farstrider Ranger Sallina; and Pathstalker Avokor, along with a large host of Silvermoon Guardians. The coalition forces are supported by Silvermoon Outrunners who ferry supplies between the capital and the Isle.



• At the direction of Ranger-General Halduron Brightwing, Blood Knight Matriarch Lady Liadrin, Knight-Lord Bloodvalor, and a host of Blood Knights and Farstriders are dispatched from Silvermoon City to assist reclamation efforts throughout Quel'Thalas.




- Farstrider **Ranger Jaela** is tasked with leading a contingent of rangers to secure the main city gates to Silvermoon, and to repulse any attacks by the Scourge.
- Farstrider ranger **Hathvelion Sungaze** is tasked with leading a small company towards the western coasts to combat and thin out the growing infestation of murlocs along the shores.
- Captain Aeldon Sunbrand and his Blood Hawk forces launch a renewed assault against the Wretched lingering in the western, ruined portions of Silvermoon City, with the intention of eliminating their leader, Thaelis the Hungerer.
 - Capture and interrogation operations are coordinated by **Sergeant Kan'ren**, and result in the capture of several Wretched in service to **Thaelis the Hungerer**.
 - Forces are dispatched by Captain Aeldon Sunbrand to reclaim the Commons Hall at the center of the western district, leading to the Battle for Dawning Lane, fought between the Wretched and Sin'dorei forces. Among the combatants participating in the assault is Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud.




- of Kaldorei infiltrators.
 - Forces are dispatched by Captain Aeldon Sunrand to investigate and eliminate any intruders at the Western Arcane Sanctum, north of Sunsail Anchorage.
 - Ley-Keeper Velania coordinates efforts at the Western Arcane Sanctum to eliminate dangerous arcane aberrations, and Kaldorei stealth operatives.
 - These efforts lead to a clash between Kaldorei scouts and the Sin'dorei forces.
 - The unstable arcane elementals in the area are eliminated, along with the Kaldorei infiltrators, and the Sanctum is restored to working order.
- A large contingent of Wretched, including some of those driven out of Silvermoon City, launch an assault against the Sunsail Anchorage in an effort to capture mana-laced cargo and siphon the energy from it.
 - Their assault, led by the former magi Aldaron-now known as Aldaron the Reckless - overwhelms the limited security forces present, and the Sin'dorei-including Captain Kelisendra and Sailor Melinan-retreat to higher ground.
 - O During the assault, numerous ships are plundered, and one is sunk in the fighting.
 - A bulwark is established along the road to the north east, and reinforcements are summoned from Silvermoon.
 - During the night after the capture of Sunsail Anchorage by the Wretched, murlocs from the western shores pillage the harbor and steal additional cargo from the unguarded ships.
- Remnant Scourge forces in northern Eversong launch an assault on the shattered front gates of Silvermoon City.
 - They are met and countered by Ranger Jaela and a cadre of rangers under her command.



- After securing the waterfront, Sin'dorei forces launch an assault against the hold, eliminate **Aldaron the Reckless**, and reclaim the port.
- **Magister Duskwither** dispatches forces to the Duskwither Spire to eliminate the threat posed by his research, which had previously resulted in the deaths of multiple apprentices.
- **Lieutenant Dawnrunner**, operating out of the Farstrider Retreat, dispatches Sin'dorei forces to engage and drive out Amani raiders attempting to capitalize on the Sin'dorei's vulnerabilities in the region.
 - The battle leads elven forces into the depths of several Amani camps throughout the Eversong Woods in which fierce fighting takes place.
- The Sin'dorei struggle internally as various factions inside the Kingdom squabble over whether to follow **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider's** path of magical consumption, or **Regent Lord Lor'themar Theron's** more steady course.
 - Ranger-Captain Erilihn Autumnsong maintains a distrust of Prince Kael'Thas Sunstrider's leadership, but continues their service and duty to the Farstriders in Quel'Thalas.
- Following the rapid advance of Sin'dorei forces pushing south through Quel'Thalas, Lord Mordanhan Skyshroud and Magistrix Gladahan Skyshroud lead a contingent of forces in recapturing Elb'athalan, the Skyshroud family estate situated on the banks of the Elrendar River.
 - Though the battle is fierce, they are able to recapture the estate, and offer its use as a forward outpost for Sin'dorei forces in their continued efforts in the south.
 - Lord Mordinathan Skyshroud continues his duties as Lord of the Skyshroud family line in Quel'Thalas, but shifts operations from Silvermoon to Elb'athalan.
 - Over the following months the estate is restored, and retainers acquired to aid in the rehabilitation of the family's influence and status.



- After mounting successes in their counter offensive, the Sin'dorei strike out at Deatholme, in the south of Quel'Thalas.
 - Baranthore Sunstriker, Magistrix Gladuhan Skyshroud, and Cael'braen Sunbreeze are among the many soldiers of Quel'Thalas dispatched to the Ghostlands to take part in the offensive.
 - O Ara'dana Dreadflame is slain by Baranthore Sunstriker during the assault on Deatholme.
 - **Dar'Khan Drathir**, leader of the Scourge's forces in Deatholme, is slain. This is seen as a major victory that earns the attention and respect of the Horde.
- Ary Wynters finally breaks from their training within Quel'Thalas, having learned enough from sorcerers and mages alike to defend themself.
 - Ary joins a mercenary group known as The Blackfoot Company.
- The Sin'dorei are formally welcomed into the Horde, and the Draenei are brought into the fold of the Alliance by way of the Kaldorei.
 - Colben Ornae throws his support towards the Sin'dorei joining with the Horde, believing the Kingdom was better off staying independent of the Alliance. Colben remains in Silvermoon throughout the Sunfury forces' continued operations in the Outlands.
 - Cael'braen Sunbreeze voices deep reservations about the Sin'dorei allying with the Horde, having had fought in the heavy battles against the orcs and trolls during the Second War.
 - Vangellis Falwellow grows more concerned with the Sin'dorei new direction, and develops strong reservations about his continued service with the Sunfury forces.



• In an effort to lure the Alliance and Horde to the Outlands to depose **Lord Illidan Stormrage**, the Burning Legion reopens the Dark Portal and invades Azeroth.


• Their invasion is rebuffed by the united defenders of Azeroth, led by the Argent Dawn, and the mortal races are lured into invading the Outlands.


- This call to action by the Horde draws confusion and unease throughout Quel'Thalas, as many of the Sin'dorei's forces followed **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** in service to **Lord Illidan**.
- The Sin'dorei forces deployed through the Dark Portal to support the Horde initially focus their efforts exclusively on the Burning Legion.

- The Hellfire Coalition -

- The Alliance and Horde stage a coordinated invasion of Hellfire Peninsula, just beyond the Dark Portal.
 - Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud of the Kirin Tor and Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker are among the many Alliance leaning forces who join the vanguard to assault the Legion's armies through the portal.
 - After a long battle, the vanguard succeeds in driving back the demonic forces guarding
 the gateway to the Outlands and the coalition drives further inland and establishes
 Thrallmar for the Horde, and reunites with Alliance forces at Honor Hold.
- Surviving members of the Alliance Expedition in the Outlands, also known as the Sons of Lothar, are reunited with forces from Azeroth whom they never imagined they'd see again.




- Many notable Sin'dorei venture forth to aid the Horde in Hellfire Peninsula.
 - **Magister Bloodhawk** is dispatched to support the Sin'dorei's efforts, and is posted to Thrallmar, in the Hellfire Peninsula of the Outlands.
 - Ranger-Captain Venn'ren leads a force composed of Sin'dorei and Forsaken soldiers, rangers, and magi to reclaim a camp previously established by Prince Kael'thas' forces in the western reaches of the Peninsula. They fortify the location and establish it as Falcon Watch. He is joined by: Magister Aledis, Arcanist Calesthris Dawnstar, Magistrix Carinda and her husband Arelion, Viera Sunwhisper, Falconer Drenna Riverwind, Ryathen the Somber, Taleris Dawngazer, Fallesh Sunfallow, and Aresella, among many other pilgrims, rangers, and magi.
- Ranger-Captain Venn'ren dispatches forces out into the wastes of Hellfire Peninsula to establish safe corridors for Sin'dorei pilgrims to travel through the Outlands.
- The Hellfire Coalition launches a coordinated assault on Hellfire Citadel.
 - Among the Alliance forces engaged in the effort are Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker and Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud.
- The Cenarion Circle establishes footholds in Zangarmarsh, Hellfire Peninsula, Terokkar Forest, and the Blade's Edge Mountains, and deals several blows to Sin'dorei, naga, and Illidari operations in those regions.
 - Tensions rise within Silvermoon as word spreads of hostility between the allegedly neutral forces of the Cenarion Expedition and the Sin'dorei in the Outlands. The lines are blurred between where the Sin'dorei's allegiances truly lie.
 - As retribution for the Cenarion Circle's incursion and sabotage, the Firewing forces in Terokkar Forest unleash their prototype mana-bomb, decimating the Cenarion Thicket, and begin hasty work to unleash another mana-bomb against the Allerian stronghold.




- Ven'rallei Stormingdawn travels with a small adventuring company beyond the Dark Portal to seek out potential items of power and relics from the Quel'dorei who ventured through the portal two decades prior with the Alliance Expedition.
 - O Not intending to find survivors, he's surprised to come face to face with survivors at the Allerian Stronghold. Though they are outwardly hostile towards him at first, Ven'rallei Stormingdawn is able to use his mercantile and diplomatic skills to establish decent relations with the Quel'dorei there.
- Magister Fanor Quel'dorah, Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud, Magister Taileth Skyshroud, and
 a number of other magisters and rangers uncover the Sin'dorei's plot to deploy a mana bomb
 against the Allerian Stronghold in Terokkar Forest.
 - They take part in an assault against Firewing Point to neutralize the mana bomb, and defeat the Firewing forces at that outpost.
- Seeking a cure for the Sin'dorei's addiction to magic, **Magistrix Elosai** travels to the Thousand Needles and begins to research and develop a tonic that would provide a cure.
 - Her research, however, backfires, and the tonic begins to accelerate her addiction to magic, leading her to wither into one of the Wretched.

- The Seer's Vision -

- Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider orders Voren'thal the Seer, commander of a large contingent of powerful sorcerers, rangers, and soldiers within the Sunfury Army, to march on Shattrath City in order to defeat or capture A'dal, leader of the Naaru in the Outlands, and to lay waste to any who resist.
- **Voren'thal the Seer** leads a large contingent of Sin'dorei forces towards Shattrath from the Sunfury's holdings in the Netherstorm.



- their forces to defeating the Burning Legion.
- Among the many who join Voren'thal in reforming into the Scryers are Magister Falris, Magistrix Fyalenn, and many others.
- A complete list of the Scryers is in the process of being compiled.
- Voren'thal the Seer dispatches a plea to Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, urging him to turn away from his current path and side with the Naaru against Lord Illidan Stormrage and their demonic allies.
 - This plea is dismissed privately, and **Voren'thal** is declared a traitor.
- Sabariel Elizabeth Greenwood Greenwood continues her pursuit of rogue demons and warlocks on Azeroth, hunting them and working to bring peace to the denizens of Azeroth where she can.
- The Sin'dorei on Azeroth remain divided in their allegiance, with many still loyal to **Kael'thas**, but also in service to the Horde and sworn to oppose the Legion. Tensions rise within the capital, and also in the Outlands where many Sin'dorei are stationed.
 - Voren'thal the Seer's defection delivers a major blow to the status quo in Silvermoon.
 - is shocked and driven to grave doubts about his allegiance when word of Voren'thal's defection reaches the Netherstorm. He contemplates abandoning Kael'thas, but understands the grave risks in doing so. For the time being, he remains put.
 - Cael braen Sunbreeze struggles with decisions about his own loyalty, having put his faith in Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider and the Sin'dorei's new path, he struggles to believe the rumors and allegations against the **Prince**.
- Well aware of the growing struggle and strife amongst the Sin'dorei, and desiring to keep the Skyshroud family unified-especially after learning of the survival of his daughter, Magistrix Taileth Skyshroud-Lord Mordrathan Skyshroud issues a summons to the living members of the Skyshroud line.




- Magistus Talerh Skyshroud in sour moods, unhappy to leave their parents, but resolute in their decision to not side with the Horde.
- Open conflict, in the form of both skirmishes and large scale battles, erupts between the Quel'dorei forces of the Alliance Expedition stationed in the Allerian Stronghold and Honor Hold, and the various Sin'dorei factions spread across the Outlands.
 - O The blood war between the children of Quel'Thalas leads to a great deal of confusion amongst the participants, particularly because the Allerian forces have missed twenty years of history on Azeroth. The outward hostility of the Sin'dorei, both those loyal to Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, and those loyal to the Horde, drives the recently re-discovered Allerian Quel'dorei firmly into the arms of the Alliance.
 - Outlands are now a lot less safe for a merchant like himself. He returns to Silvermoon City in Quel'Thalas and begins to work through adventurers to gather artifacts.
- Despite having forged a coalition to battle against the Legion, the Horde and Alliance forces present in the Outlands engage in numerous skirmishes and battles for control of resources and territories.
 - The leadership of both factions refrain from engaging their forces into an outright, open conflict.
- Coalition forces fight against the armies of Lord Illidan Stormrage, Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, and Lady Vashj, all across the Outlands.



- out at **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and **Lord Illidan Stormrage's** Eclipsion and Illidari forces.

 Chancellor Bloodleaf is killed by Sha'tari forces in Shadowmoon Valley while
- working to recruit the giants to the Eclipsion's efforts in service to Lord Illidan Stormrage.
- Agents of the Scourge, roaming the frozen wastes of Icecrown, uncover the elven runeblade
 <u>Felo'melorn</u>, left behind when **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and **Lord Illidan's** forces
 retreated from Icecrown after losing the battle against **Arthas** during the Third War.
 - The runeblade is brought to the Icecrown Citadel and stored within the fortress, mounted upon a pedestal in one of the countless halls inside.
- During his time in the Outlands, Master Sorcerer Ansinosth Summerbough begins to hunt a particularly fierce Nathrezim by the name of **Xaz'akiz**, who is believed to have stolen the souls and attunement crystals belonging to fellow sorcerers of Ansinosth's order, individuals who were with the Alliance Expedition. The potential usage of the crystals by the dreadlord puts the order's vaults and sanctums at risk of perversion.
 - **Xaz'akiz** manages to lure Ansinosth into the Nether, trapping them both beyond the earthly planes of the Outlands.
 - Trapped together, Ansinosth and the Dreadlord battle for what, to them, would appear to be years, though given the known flux effects tied to the passage of time within the nether, only mere weeks pass.
 - Despite securing victory over the Nathrezim, Ansinosth suffers terrible mental and physical scars as a result of the protracted battle.



- **Spymaster Thalodien** is dispatched by the Scryers to collect information on the disposition of Sunfury forces in the Netherstorm.
- Cael braen Sunbreeze, Lord Mor'drathan Skyshroud, and Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud take
 part in a secret conclave of sorcerers and magi in Silvermoon where the discussion of their
 loyalty is debated. Many remain divided on who to back in the political schism unfolding
 within the Kingdom.
 - After considerable debate, the sorcerers and magi vote to back the Regent Lord, deeming the opposition to the Prince to be too significant to have any chance of success.
- At the Coilfang Reservoir, **Lady Vashj** meets her fate at the hands of the Coalition forces arrayed against her.
- Sha'tar and Coalition forces stage an all out assault against the Sunfury's fortified holdings in the Netherstorm.
 - Magister Feanor Quel'dorah, Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud, and Magistrix Tailerh
 Skyshroud all contribute to the assault against the Sunfury forces.
 - Magister Framor Quel dorah allies himself with the Draenei forces that are present during this time, and he develops a kindred sort of bond with the Draenei–a people likewise who refused to embrace darker magics for power.
 - After the securing of the region, Maginer Wanor Quel'doral returns to the Allerian Stronghold, just before the final assault on the Tempest Keep.
- The Sha'tar and Coalition forces launch a coordinated, four-pronged assault on the Tempest Keep vessels.
 - Prince Kael'thas' Sunfury, Crimson Hand, Bloodwarder, and Sunseeker forces fight
 back against the incursions and, under the leadership of Thaladred the Darkener,
 Lord Sanguinar, Grand Astromancer Capernian, Master Engineer Telonicus,
 Commander Sarannis, and Pathaleon the Calculator, make a stand within the
 Tempest Keep.



- blown loose in the epic battle, strikes him and becomes lodged in his chest.
- The arrival of the demon priestess **Delrissa** enables **Kael'thas** to escape before death.
- One of Prince Kael'thas' Verdant Spheres-the moon crystals empowering the three Moon Gates of Quel'Thalas-is left behind and taken by Coalition forces after his defeat.
- is captured aboard the Tempest Keep station and taken into custody by forces of the Sha'tar. He is taken to Shattrath where he is held as a prisoner.
- In the wake of the battle for the Tempest Keep structure, Archmage Vorathel Skyshroud, and Magistrix Taileth Skyshroud manage to recover the body of Vorathel's brother-Taileth's cousin-Captain Daine Skyshroud, a spellbreaker in service to the Sunfury Forces.
 - O Body in tow, they deliver Daine's remains to the Skyshroud family estate in Quel'Thalas, which brings them back to their parents, Magistrix Gladathan Skyshroud, and Lord Mordrathan Skyshroud. The family reunion is somber, but there are gratitudes exchanged for bringing home Daine's body.





- The Battle for Quel'Thalas -

• **Prince Kael'thas** is healed by the Legion, and he subsequently leads his Dawnblade, Shadowsword, and Sunblade forces to retake the Isle of Quel'danas, in Quel'Thalas.

Lord Illidan Stormrage is killed in the Black Temple and his demon hunters captured


O Mespir Iverweem is among the Sunfury forces that relocate to the Isle of Quel'danas, where he is conscripted into the Dawnblade forces. He is kept largely in the dark with regards to the true extent of **Kael'thas'** fall to madness - and continues his service to the Prince.

- Prince Kael'thas' felblood Shadowsword forces assault Silvermoon city and recapture M'uru, the Naaru gifted to Silvermoon which has served as a source of power for Lady Liadrin's Blood Knight paladins.
 - Witnessing the assault on her people by the very Prince she'd sworn to follow, Lady Liadrin denounces Kael'thas and pledges her Blood Knights to the Naaru and the Sin'dorei under Lor'themar.
 - Though not witness to the battles at the Blood Knight's bastion in Silvermoon,





- the light of the Naaru.
 Baranthore Sunstriker, loyal to Lady Liadrin, joins her Blood Knights in forming the Shattered Sun Offensive.
- Cael'braen Sunbreeze joins with the forces of the Shattered Sun, and brings many other sorcerers into the fold as well. His hatred of demons ensures his opposition to the Prince.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker reluctantly joins with the forces of the Shattered Sun Offensive, though she faces anxieties about returning home given Quel'Thalas' alignment with the Horde.
- O Zahue Planeblade is dispatched to the Isle of Quel'Danas to survey the Plateau as the Dawnblade forces under **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** cement their hold on the Isle.
- The Amani trolls lash out at the forces of the Horde and Alliance on Azeroth while their armies are distracted in the Outlands, believing this to be an opportunity to reclaim territory and power that was once lost. Their transgression prompts a swift response.
- **Kael'thas Sunstrider** directs the remnants of his forces to repurpose the Sunwell for enabling the arrival of the demon lord **Kil'jaeden** into Azeroth.
 - He is supported by his Dawnblade, Shadowsword, and Sunblade forces, who work to rebuild and fortify the Sunwell Plateau.
- Lady Liadrin and the Naaru leading the Shattered Sun Offensive stage an incursion onto the Isle of Quel'Danas, home to the Sunwell.
- The Alliance and Horde support the Shattered Sun Offensive as they wage war against **Kil'jaeden** and **Kael'thas'** forces. The efforts draw in many Quel'dorei and Sin'dorei who are eager to liberate the Sunwell, including:
 - Farstriders Halduron Brightwing, Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker, and
 Seraphina Bloodheart; logistics coordinators Captain Theris Dawnhearth, Eldara



- The initial assault focuses attention on the harbor and staging ground areas, where the Offensive wages a fierce battle to wrest control of a beachhead from the Dawnblade forces.
 - Arcania Hespir Everwaern is among the many Dawnblade and Sunfury forces to counter the Shattered Sun's incursion at Sun's Reach Harbor. He leads many sorties, mounted on dragonhawk, and unleashed devastating fire spells upon the attacking coalition forces.
 - One of Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider's lieutenants, the fel infused Selin Fireheart—once a captain of his personal guard—secures the entrance to the Magister's Terrace as Shattered Sun forces begin to establish the staging ground.
- The Shattered Sun Offensive wrests control of the Sun's Reach arcane sanctum, the forge, harbor and the staging ground, and then the town center; the Dawnblade forces are driven out.
 - The Dawnblade forces work to blockade the harbor after its capture, drawing in the support of three elven destroyers: *The Dawnchaser*, *The Sin'loren*, and *The Bloodoath*.
 - O Commander Venthar Starbreeze and Captain Zandayn Starbreeze, aboard Silverspell and Dawning Sword, engage the Dawnblade's naval forces off the coast of the Isle of Quel'Danas, with Captain Zandayn Starbreeze's Dawnfire Squadron gaining renown for their lightning strikes against the Dawnblade's forces.
 - Dragonhawk riders in service to the Shattered Sun Offensive begin conducting regular sorties to drive back the blockading ships.
- With Sun's Reach liberated from the Dawnblade forces, the Shattered Sun Offensive begins to assault the larger township of Dawnstar Village, the main base of operations for the Dawnblade elves under **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and his demonic allies.



• The Shattered Sun Offensive assaults the Magister's Terrace and breaches its outer gates.

• **Selin Fireheart** commands the defense of the Terrace, but is quickly confronted by the Offensive's most elite forces. The resulting battle leaves considerable damage within the front halls and chambers of the Terrace, and concludes with the defeat and death of **Selin Fireheart**.

arcane elemental **Vexallus** emerges in the depths of the Terrace. The summoning casters are slain upon the elemental's arrival, and arcane anomalies spread throughout the chambers, forcing Dawnblade forces to navigate around the chamber and seal it off

- Cael'braen Sunbreeze continues to battle demons and Dawnblade forces in the areas surrounding the Sunwell Plateau.
- The Shattered Sun Offensive's elite strike forces encounter and defeat the unstable arcane elemental known as **Vexallus**.
- The Shattered Sun's strike force, Zalvie Hameblade included, engages the shivarra **Priestess**Delrissa—the demon responsible for **Prince Kael'thas** rescue from the Tempest Keep after his defeat—in the lower courtyards of the Terrace.
 - The demon priestess draws upon support from Ellrys Duskhallow, Eramas Brightblaze, Kagani Nightstrike, as well as a handful of otherworldly monsters and demons.
 - The fierce battle results in the destruction of numerous mana cubes—which store energy siphoned from the Netherstorm—dealing further damage to the terrace.
 - Priestess Delrissa and her allies are slain, and the Shattered Sun strike force advances deep into the bowels of the Magister's Terrace and confronts Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider.




• Within the Sunwell Plateau, Arcanis Hespir Twerwyern is among many of the younger Sunfury magi and captured Shattered Sun soldiers who are to be sacrificed as fuel to support the opening of the Sunwell as a gate for **Kil'jaeden**.

- Arcanust Flespir narrowly manages to escape such a fate, but is traumatized by a close encounter with a Fel addled Sin'dorei summoner. The near death experience and over exposure to brutal Fel energies prompts a mental breakdown in the young sorcerer.
- Shattered Sun forces stage a daring assault on the Plateau's southern gateway, seeking to drive their assault straight into the Sunwell's main building.
 - Cael'braen Sunbreeze is among the scores of Shattered Sun forces that stage the assault, and they battle furiously, deep into the lines of both undead and demons.



- With **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** at long last defeated, and the Magister's Terrace secured, the Shattered Sun Offensive begins its assault on the Sunwell Plateau.
 - Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker is among the Shattered Sun forces who assault the Plateau, but she is not part of the forces who penetrate the inner chambers.
 - Arcanist Horpir Everweem, among many other soldiers of the Dawnblade and Sunfury forces, is captured by the Shattered Sun Offensive's forces and placed under arrest.

 Arcanist Margin is placed under close watch due to his unstable mental state.
 - The Dawnblade, Shadowsword, and Sunblade forces within the Sunwell Plateau are defeated, and many of their number are taken prisoner.
 - The demon lord **Kil'jaeden** emerges through the Sunwell.
 - Stationed just outside of the Plateau at the time, Zabie Plameblade, and the many other elven forces on the Isle are all witness to the demon's arrival, and feel the overwhelming presence of his chaotic energy.
- The Shattered Sun Offensive wages a fierce battle against the demon lord Kil'jaeden within the Sunwell Plateau.
 - Kil'jaeden is defeated and cast back through the Sunwell.
- The Sunwell is purified by the Draenei **Prophet Velen** using the spark of the Naaru **M'uru** who had been slain during the battle for the Plateau.
 - The Isle of Quel'danas is returned to the Sin'dorei, with a neutrality clause that permits the Quel'dorei to return with unrestricted visitation rights as Pilgrims.



- The cohort agrees to remain in contact and pursue new research together.
- Among the many projects they discuss and begin work on is a method of linking the various arcane sanctums across Quel'Thalas to the leylines in a more efficient method where the flow of energy can be redirected, instead of remaining static.
- Master Sorcerer Ansinosth also consorts with fellow members of the Elrendar Fellowship who had remained in Quel'Thalas after the Fall, and begins to take stock of which of his apprentices may possibly be still alive. Given the incomplete records and scattered state of Quel'Thalas, even with the massive progress made, he is only able to account for a small handful.
- Malyie Planidshide remains on the Isle of Quel'danas to work alongside the Draenei, and to aid in the restoration of the Isle and the clean up efforts after the end of the fighting.
- Ranger-Captain Kandravia Boltseeker learns that her father, Magister Sallastus Boltseeker, had survived the fall of Dalaran and had aligned himself with the Sin'dorei, and the Horde.
 - Resentful of his willingness to side with the elves' long time enemies, Ranger-Captain Kandravia disavows the Boltseeker name, and adopts her mother's maiden name, Silverblossom.
- Magister Feuror Quel dorah elects to remain in the Outlands, at the Allerian Stronghold with many of the other Quel'dorei who were scorned and made enemies of by the Sin'dorei under Prince Kael'thas.






- Aeydark Bal'annor is one of the many Death Knights freed from the Lich King's dominion.
- Aeydark Bal'annor returns to Quel'Thalas and comes face to face with the new reality that has taken hold.

Silver Hand and the Argent Dawn into the Argent Crusade.

- Hostility towards the Ebon Blade, and the undead in general, drives Aeydark Bal'annor away, however, and he departs to wander the land.
- Ouring this time Aeydark Bal'annor learns that it is likely his wife, and their unborn child, were slain during the Fall of Silvermoon, along with his parents, whose grave he locates
- The worgen curse continues to spread throughout Gilneas, transforming its people into the feral and savage worgen.
- Regent Lord Lor'themar Theron travels south and visits the Quel'Lithien Lodge on the border of Quel'Thalas and eastern Lordaeron.
 - Meeting with Ranger-Lord Hawkspear, one of the many elves the Regent Lord banished from Quel'Thalas years before for not adhering to the new teachings of Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider, his welcome was less than friendly.
 - Obspite offering the Quel'dorei supplies and resources, the **Regent Lord** is rebuffed and ordered to leave, judged to be an enemy for abiding the Horde's earlier efforts to sack the Lodge, which resulted in the deaths of numerous rangers and magi.
- Arcania Hespir Everwyern, imprisoned still as an enemy combatant, is presented with a deal on behalf of the Regency of Quel'Thalas. In exchange for his freedom, he is forced to publicly renounce **Prince Kael'thas Sunstrider** and formally declare his loyalties to Quel'Thalas.
 - Arcanis Hospie Everwyern returns to Silvermoon and resumes his studies in the arcane, now under Magister Korus. Having suffered tremendous traumas in recent
